Outside, the cottage is set in beautifully maintained gardens, with a southfacing patio and a lovely clematis-draped arbor, offering an ideal spot for al fresco dining. Guests can enjoy the tranquil surroundings while taking in views of Painswick's famous church yard, home to ninety-nine magnificent yew trees. The village itself is renowned for its rich history and stunning countryside, with plenty of walking trails, charming villages, and local attractions, including the famous Rococo Gardens, all just a short distance away.

Location & Local Information


Painswick Cottage is ideally situated in the heart of the picturesque village of Painswick, often referred to as "The Queen of the Cotswolds." Painswick is also home to the famous Rococo Gardens, the only surviving complete Rococo garden in England, offering breathtaking floral displays, especially in early spring when snowdrops carpet the grounds.

For those seeking outdoor adventure, Painswick is halfway along the Cotswold Way National Trail, providing excellent hiking opportunities with stunning views from Painswick Beacon. Cyclists will appreciate the Cotswolds and Severn Vale 7day cycle tour passing through the village.

Nearby attractions include Woodchester Valley Vineyard, where guests can enjoy wine tasting, and the historic towns of Cheltenham and Gloucester, offering cultural events, boutique shopping, and renowned festivals. Whether you're exploring on foot, by bike, or simply relaxing in the village, Painswick Cottage serves as the perfect base to experience the charm and beauty of the Cotswolds.
