This stunning villa is located on the wonderful Island of Pasman in the Zadar archipelago, separated from the Croatian mainland and the towns of Zadar and Biograd by the Pasman Channel. Villa Lelia, originally built in 1812 and oozing characterful appeal, is made up of a main house and several outbuildings housing many of the idyllic bedroom suites. The buildings surround a wonderful swimming pool and various terraces. To the front of the property is a gorgeous, beautifully planted garden.

The villa is situated in the village of Tkon on Pasman. It can be reached by ferry from Biograd in just 15 minutes. Once you have arrived, you can walk to restaurants, cafes, supermarkets and stunning beaches. The nearest beach is directly in front the villa, very hard to beat.

Villa Lelia features beautiful exposed stone walls and vast brilliant white walls which look like a gallery. Certainly the huge pieces of contemporary art look perfect in their settings. Within the main house, you will find the chef's dream of a kitchen with its sleek, shiny cupboards and excellent appliances. This is also the interior dining area with two tables and chairs for such a large group. The exposed stone walls blend perfectly with the furniture and kitchen cabinetry. The games room is another delight with a profssional billiard table and table football.

All nine bedrooms are palatial gems, all very individual and uniquely decorated. They are extravagant, opulent and incredibly spacious. Most feature exposed stone walls,







huge contemporary artworks and enormous beds in the centre of the room. Each has a lavish bathroom, some of which are tucked away but others are central and very much part of the room. You will find bedroom suites with sumptuous seating arrangements, some with terrace access and most with gorgeous, panoramic views towards the small harbour and beach. You will find chandeliers, velvet day beds, vaulted ceilings and probably some of the biggest beds you have ever seen! 

### **Location & Local Information**

The Island of Pasman is part of the Zadar archipelago, situated off the mainland between Zadar and Sibenik. Pasman is known as the island with the largest green surface in Croatia. The rapid Pasman stream changes course every six hours and makes the sea one of the clearest in the Adriatic. There are remains of Roman architecture, stone inscriptions and coins confirming that the island was inhabited during the Roman rule in Dalmatia. Visitors can explore the primative fortifications at elevated sites in the Illyric town Gradine. Above Tkon, on the beautiful hill of Cokovac, is the Benedictine monastery of St Cosmos and Damien which dates back to 1125. In Kraj you will find a Franciscan monastery built in 1390. There are numerous sandy bays around the coastline of the island including seven between Tkon and Ugrinic. The most famous beach is Matlovac in Zdrelac and Tratica in Kraj is also very popular with families. The gastronomy of Pasman is centred around fish, locally grown vegetables, Dalmation herbs and Dalmation olive oil. Some specialities include prosciutto dried on the bura north wind, salted cheese from the Island of Pag and lamb. There are not any nightclubs on the island but there are some buzzy beach bars. If you want a nightclub then you should head for Zadar.

From Pasman, you can enjoy many day trips. You can visit the neighbouring Island of Uglijan via a bridge, one of the national parks including the Kornati National Park, the Krka waterfalls and Paklenica National Park or one of the towns along the coast. It is quick to get to Zadar, Sibenik, Trogir or Split. You may want a days hiking in the Velebit mountain range or a rafting trip on the Zrmanja River. The Nature Park Telascica and the Lake Vrana are both beautiful.

The dramatic, wild mountain range of Velebit is sensational with two national parks, the Northern Velebit National Park and the Paklenica National Park, a biosphere reserve, forests, deep canyons, caves, paths, cycle routes, botanical gardens and exciting wildlife including Balkam chamois, red deer, brown bears, wolf and lynx. In the









foothills of Velebit, the Modric cave is an absolute gem. Velebit's Church of Sv Juraj (St. George) in the heart of the town is a fantastic example of ancient Croatian architecture. Velebit is the largest, though not the highest, mountain range in Croatia, forming part of the Dinaric Alps. The popular spots are the peak of Vucjak above Zavizan, the botanical gardens and the caves.

The richly historic town of Zadar offers many attractions. Zadar's renowned sunsets are spectacular and to celebrate them, a 'Monument to the Sun' was built on the edge of the waterfront. It is an all day 22 metre disc which soaks up the solar rays ready to dazzle visitors with coloured light patterns as night falls. The Sea Organ is an art installation formed by cleverly cutting steps into the promenade with underwater pipes making musical sounds.

The breathtaking Kornati Archipelago National Park boasts reefs, headlands, islands and bays. You can take boat trips to explore the national park with plenty of opportunity to swim and snorkel. The famous Krka National Park boasts its stunning Skradinksi Buk and Roski Slap waterfalls. Extending along the 73km Krka River, the park runs from the Adriatic near Sibenik inland to the mountains of the Croatian interior. It is a magical place of gorges and waterfalls, with the river gushing through. Visitors take a boat ride to explore the park. Make sure you take your swimming costumes as you can swim below the waterfalls. Visitors also pass by the magnificent Visovac monastery, located on an island in a magical setting while on the boat ride.

Sibenik is the city of fortresses with two UNESCO heritage sites, Game of Thrones locations, beautiful beaches, an excellent dining scene and a gorgeous old town. Sibenik was first mentioned in 1066 though most of it was built during the Venetian rule between 1412 and 1797. St James Cathedral is a beautiful masterpiece of Venetian art built in the 15th century. The town's fortresses include St John's Fortress, Fortress Barone, St Michael's, the oldest and most famous and the scene of many summer performances and festivals and St Nicholas. St Nicholas, another Game of Thrones location, is reached via an

official boat tour from Riva which includes a boat ride through St Anthony's channel.
