



Location & Local Information

Surrounded by 45km of plains and steep cliffs, Plouguerneau is located in the heart of the Pays des Abers and rich in cultural activities for families of all ages. Begin with the inescapable dolmens. The one in Lilia displays no less than 9 meters of wingspan and is a classified Historical Monument. Further on, you can admire the site of Iliz Koz. Follow the itinerary, which takes you through the ruins and follows onto an adjoining museum.

For something a little different, Plouguerneau, famous for its seaweed harvest, invites you to visit the eco-museum of seaweed and algae, where you will be able to discover the multiple applications of this particular alga.

And for those with a penchant for watersports, the sailing club offers a range of activities such as sailing, windsurfing and catamaran trips. But if you'd rather stay on land, there are many places to go hiking or horse riding - it is up to you to choose your means of transport to discover the surrounding countryside.
