Location & Local Information

Villa Colombe is in a highly desirable residential area just a 750m stroll from Le Club 55 and Pampelonne Beach, one of the most iconic beaches in southern France.

Indeed, Plage de Pampelonne is an unmissable jewel of the French Riviera. Stretching over five kilometres, this pristine beach is a masterpiece of natural beauty, where soft golden sands meet crystal-clear waters. It's famed for its vast range of summer watersports and exclusive beachside restaurants.

If you are fortunate to reserve a place, visit the legendary beach club, Le Club 55. Founded in 1955, this iconic beach club began as a humble spot for cast and crew during the filming of And God Created Woman. Today, it's a symbol of understated elegance, where celebrities and discerning travellers mingle over exquisite Mediterranean cuisine. Dining at Le Club 55 is more than a meal; it's a celebration of Saint-Tropez's effortlessly chic and luxurious lifestyle.

A short drive away, Saint-Tropez (4.5km) beckons with its storied charm and cosmopolitan flair. Wander through the cobbled streets of the historic old town, and lose yourself among its boutique-lined alleys showcasing designer labels. The vibrant Place des Lices market, held twice a week, is a treasure trove of artisanal goods and Provençal produce. For art lovers, the Musée de l'Annonciade showcases an impressive collection of post-Impressionist masterpieces, paying homage to the town's artistic heritage.

Just a stone's throw away lies Ramatuelle (6km), a picturesque village perched on a hilltop overlooking the Mediterranean. Its narrow, flower-adorned streets invite leisurely exploration, while its stunning views provide a serene contrast to the lively energy of Saint-Tropez. Ramatuelle's annual jazz festival, held each summer, is a cultural highlight, drawing world-class musicians and audiences to its enchanting open-air setting.
