### **Overview**



Set across a vast 3.5-hectare private park, the main house blends sophisticated interiors with architectural character. Inside, a series of carefully curated spaces unfolds: a grand salon ideal for evening gatherings, a cinema room, and a dining room designed for long, convivial meals. The billiards table adds a leisurely touch, while each of the three gorgeous bedroom suites are bathed in soft light and finished with elegant detailing.

Step outside, and the graceful patio leads to two additional guest bedrooms, whilst a separate apartment complete with a lounge, kitchen, and three pretty bedrooms offers the perfect setup for larger groups or multigenerational stays.

Days at Maison Cactus are shaped by possibility. Start with a swim in the heated pool, then unwind in the spa area, where a sauna and jacuzzi promise deep relaxation. For those seeking a more active rhythm, a dedicated gym features premium equipment and outside, a private tennis court and expansive lawns invite play and leisurely strolls alike.

Beyond your doorstep, explore the wild beauty of Les Alpilles through scenic hikes, horseback rides, or cycling trails. Historic villages and towns like Les Baux-de-Provence and Saint-Rémy-de-Provence lie just a short drive away, offering cobbled streets or galleries and



traditional markets that pulse with local life. Whether you're in search of culture, calm, or countryside adventure, this exceptional setting offers it all.

### **Location & Local Information**

Maison Cactus is set in its own private grounds close to the village of Mouriès (3km). Set just off the main road connecting the village and Saint-Martin-de-Crau, this is a great location for exploring Les Alpilles and beyond.

Mouriès is a picturesque Provençal village that captures the essence of southern France. Renowned for its olive oil heritage and tranquil pace of life, Mouriès is a delight to explore, with its charming stone houses, Wednesday morning market and friendly cafés shaded by plane trees. In the heart of the Vallée des Baux, it's the ideal base for discovering the raw beauty, culture, and culinary treasures of this captivating corner of Provence.

A short drive brings you to Les Baux-de-Provence (12km), a medieval marvel perched on a rocky outcrop with panoramic views over the Vallée des Baux. Wander its cobbled lanes lined with artisan shops, then step into the spellbinding world of Carrières de Lumières, where art comes to life inside a former quarry.

Just down the road, Maussane-les-Alpilles (8km) and Paradou (9km) offer a taste of authentic village life with excellent local restaurants, wine bars, and a warm Provençal welcome. The atmospheric market in Maussane takes place on a Thursday morning whist food lovers won't want to miss Le Bistrot du Paradou, so loved by celebrity chefs such as Rick Stein.

To the north, Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (17km) beckons with its blend of Roman history, boutique shopping, and artistic soul. Discover the ruins of Glanum, stroll the leafy boulevards, and visit the monastery where Van Gogh painted some of his most iconic works.

Head south to Arles (28km), a UNESCO-listed gem bursting with Roman monuments, vibrant markets, and contemporary cultural energy. Its amphitheatre and the Fondation Vincent van Gogh are must-visits for history and art lovers alike.





For a memorable day out, lose yourself in the medieval charm of Avignon (45km), home to the majestic Palais des Papes; explore the Roman treasures and elegant boulevards of Nîmes (52km); or soak up the relaxed sophistication of Aix-en-Provence (62km), with its treelined avenues and thriving café culture. Alternatively, venture into the Luberon to uncover hilltop villages like Gordes and Roussillon, each more picturesque than the last.
