

### **Location & Local Information**


Kos island is an island of huge contrasts. It has some very buzzy towns with brilliant, thriving nightlife but also quiet, family-friendly resorts, huge sandy beaches, secluded hidden coves, breathtaking mountainous scenery, restaurants and cafes serving delicious local food and wines and many historic buildings and monuments.

Kos Town, the island's capital, is attractive, cosmopolitan and a vibrant reflection of the island's rich history at every turn. Visitors can witness first-hand the remains of its history in the buildings and monuments scattered around the city. Roman, Greek, Byzantine and Ottoman ruins sit next to cobblestone streets and alleys together with imposing Italian-era buildings. Incredible archaeological buildings include Neratzia Castle. The Archaeological Museum, situated in the central square boasts a wealth of sculptures from the Hellenistic to the late Roman eras including a statue of Hippocrates and a 3rd century AD mosaic. The picturesque harbour is lined with cafes and restaurants. It is a great place to stop for a drink and watch the excursion boats, fishing vessels and luxury yachts bobbing in the water. The comprehensive bike lane network is wonderful for the city's cyclists. Finikon street is stunning with its swaying palm trees.

Alikes Salt Lakes Tagaki is a popular sightseeing spot on the north of the island. The lake attracts many birds and especially beautiful flamingoes. It makes a change from the beach.

Kardamena sits on the shores of the Carpathian Sea with its amazing beach stretching for miles. It is set against a backdrop of the Kalymnos and Kappari majestic mountains. Holidays on Kos are not complete without a visit to this bustling tourist hotspot. It is very popular for guests who want a mixture of relaxing atmosphere and spirited nightlife. Nights out are centred on the town's square.

The islet of Kastri is right opposite the beach in Kefalos. It is totally rocky and barren with just some remains of an old









castle on the top and a small chapel in blue and white which is used for weddings. Kastri islet can be reached by boat or swimming from Kefalos beach.
