Overview

Set over three levels on Naxos's serene southwest coast, the villa commands a prime hillside position, offering soul-stirring sea views by day and a magical interplay of moonlight and stars by night.

Thoughtfully designed to honour the island's architectural heritage, Villa Rubie is defined by clean lines, generous terraces, and a layout that prioritises space and privacy. Each room features its own entrance, creating a sense of effortless independence for guests. Inside, the mood is one of relaxed sophistication—from the open-plan kitchen and lounge that flows into the pool terrace, to the bedrooms where splashes of joyful colour animate the calming whites. Outside, landscaped gardens and dim-lit terraces blend seamlessly into the wild beauty of the hillside, while the private pool becomes a refreshing focal point for slow afternoons.

Days here unfold in rhythm with the landscape. Begin with coffee overlooking the sea, then wander down to the wide, windswept sands of Glyfada. Venture further to discover cedar-fringed coves or savour local dishes in nearby tavernas. As the sun sets, return to your perch above the bay—where the only lights come from the pool, the stars, and the moon rising just above the horizon.

For those craving untamed coastal beauty and a villa designed for togetherness and seclusion, Villa Rubie is a place where every moment feels naturally elevated.


Location & Local Information

Tucked away on Naxos's unspoiled southwest coast, Villa Rubie enjoys an enviable setting just above the peaceful stretch of Glyfada Beach. This part of the island is known for its natural beauty—undulating dunes dotted with cedar trees, golden sands, and clear, shallow waters that remain blissfully uncrowded. The immediate surroundings are tranquil and rural, ideal for guests seeking quietude and privacy.

A short stroll brings you to Glyfada Beach, while traditional tavernas nearby serve up authentic Naxian flavours, with freshly grilled seafood and local cheeses. Just behind the villa, Oskelos Hill rises with panoramic views over the bay —perfect for a sunrise walk or sundown photo. Though wonderfully remote, the villa is just 15 km from Naxos Town and its lively harbourfront, offering the best of both worlds. A car or bike is essential for exploring, giving you the freedom to uncover hidden coves, rustic villages, and the island's timeless Cycladic charm at your own pace.
