

With a 5 km stretch of sultry sands from Verga to the city's port, you're promised a myriad of seafront hotels, eateries and bars. Rista Beach is just down the road from the villa. Its azure blue waters are ideal for fishing, canoeing and snorkelling. Other popular choices include Chalikias, Salio, Dolphins, Kalamitsi, Foneas and Neo Proastio.

Spend an afternoon foraging the cobblestone streets of Old Kardamyli. Go cafe hopping or marvel at the grand Tower of Mourtzinos. Visit the gorgeous church of Agios Spiridon. Built in Byzantium, it features an impressive belfry. There are several charming villages near Kardamyli that are well worth a visit. Enjoy the scenic beaches of Stoupa and savour the unique Byzantine culture in Agios Nikolaos. Check out the hidden gems of Itilo and Areopolis or explore the fascinating Diros caves.
