Overview

Villa Trinity is a stately feature of the green hillside overlooking beautiful Lake Maggiore and popular town of Stresa. Impressing with its historic elegance and the expansive gardens, this villa is the perfect retreat for a large family looking for rest and relaxation, yet just a short drive away from Stresa's lakeside promenade and its historic centre with craft shops, restaurants and cafes.

The villa boasts five characterful bedrooms, with each featuring pieces of antique furniture for a lovely sense of history and heritage. This look and feel is carried through to all of Villa Trinity's tastefully-furnished living spaces over three spacious floors.

Get together for a family film night in the cosy snug with TV, and to enjoy meals in the elegant dining room. Both spaces feature beautiful high ceilings for added atmosphere. The main living room is suited to more formal occasions, or for simply unwinding with a drink in front of the fire on chilly evenings.

Several of the bedrooms open directly onto balcony terraces with stunning views over Lake Maggiore. You can also appreciate the scenery from around the extensive plot that Villa Trinity nestles within. Stroll through leafy gardens and head up to the private pool for a refreshing dip and to get some of the very best views of all. Enjoy al fresco dining under the shade of mature trees as you soak up the sense of tranquillity that surrounds you in this privileged spot.

The Lake Maggiore area offers plenty to see and do. Within easy reach of the villa are hills and mountains for adventurous hikes and bike rides. Towns such as Stresa and Arona are great for historic sightseeing and catching ferries over to other picturesque spots along Lake Maggiore. Visit the Borromean Islands to discover stately houses and immaculate gardens.

Cannobio is another lovely town to explore on a day trip, with its historic buildings and attractive harbour. Just under a 90-minute drive away is the city of Milan where you can shop 'til you drop!

Location & Local Information

Villa Trinity sits in a tranquil, hillside setting, close to the beautiful waters of Lake Maggiore and surrounded by lush greenery. The drive into the nearest town, picturesque Stresa, takes just 10 minutes. Here you'll find a great choice of restaurants, bars and shops.

Right by the waterside in Stresa is impressive Villa Pallavicino with its immaculate gardens and exotic zoo. For something a bit more adventurous, take the 20-minute cable car ride from the town's lido to the top of Mottarone mountain. Enjoy breathtaking views over the town, Lake Maggiore and even see the popular ski areas. Finish a day out by having a fresh fish lunch at one of the waterside restaurants.

Stresa is also a good starting point for exploring the wider area by ferry. Catch a service over to the Borromean Islands, which are comprised of Isola Bella, Isola dei Pescatori and Isola Madre. Isola Madre is home to a huge botanical garden, with Isola Bella boasting a 17th-century palace and gardens. Isola dei Pescatori is the smallest of the islands and is famous for its red-roofed fishermen's houses.

Another lovely town to visit is Arona. It has an attractive lakeside promenade and plenty of historic streets and piazzas to discover. Cultural sightseeing comes mostly in the form of the little churches found dotted across the town and hills. Also be sure to explore the remains of Rocca, an ancient military fortress. Probably Arona's most-famous attraction is the huge hilltop statue of San Carlo.

Other great places for a day trip include lakeside Cannobio with its historic churches, *palazzos* and pretty harbour, and Milan for its luxury shops.
