Chateau Des Lauzes

Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 16

Overview

This outstanding historic château, awarded five stars by the Périgord board, allows you to experience first-class facilities alongside the very best of Dordogne. Set in over 60 acres of glorious grounds of woodland, fields and even a lake, Château des Lauzes offers beautiful accommodation between the Vézère and Dordogne rivers with so much for everyone across its stylish interiors and vast estate.

The château dates back to the 17th-century and is typically Périgordian in style with its towers, windows and shutters; look out for the locally sourced limestone, *lauzes*, protecting the roofs. There's an air of fairy-tale charm as you wander around the grounds, gazing at the mesmerising château framed by ancient trees and splashes of summer colour from the terracotta pots, hanging baskets and gardens.

Inside, the historic ambience continues across the two wings, over which eight bedrooms are scattered. In the oldest wing, a sumptuous lounge by the open fire awaits and a dining room with space for every guest is wonderful for feasts prepared in the well-equipped kitchen. Five elegant bedrooms can be found in this wing including a grand master suite at the top of one of the towers with panoramic views from each of the four windows.

The second wing offers a further three bedrooms, some with pretty balconies or terraces as well as a large living room leading on to a delightful round terrace with remarkable valley views. Throughout both wings of the château, the newly renovated bedrooms have been thoughtfully styled with antique furnishings and pretty touches to create a grand yet homely ambience.

Yet this château isn't just about its history and Dordogne charm, the 21st century facilities will amaze you too. Downstairs there's an impressive cinema room; bring your own DVDs and Blu-rays or watch a film on Netflix - kids will love the twinkling lights on the ceiling! There's also an indoor hot tub and a brilliantly equipped gym.

Summers can be spent by the swimming pool, perhaps preparing lunch in the lovely Pool House and enjoying it under the gazebo in this gorgeous setting. Wander over to the lake with its own boat and skip over the bridge to the enchanting lake house on an island, a dedicated space for massages. Not to mention the many acres of fields and woodland; look out for old pine trees, chestnuts, weeping willows and the magnificent planes that greet you as you arrive.

With so many fantastic facilities set amongst such natural beauty, it will be hard to leave your stylish retreat. Yet you are so perfectly positioned for so many sights of the Périgord Noir. Within a 10-minute drive you can be on the banks of the Dordogne, hiring canoes or enjoying a riverside picnic, perhaps with produce picked up from the Sunday morning market in the local







medieval village, just 4km away.

Other amazing places to visit include archetypal riverside villages such as Domme, Beynac-et-Cazenac and La Roque-Gageac, some offering boat trips along the Dordogne, as well as the magnificent town of Sarlat-la-Canéda. The Vézère valley is also so close, as is the market town of Le Bugue and Les Eyzies with its pre-historic treasures.

The delightful château owners can guide you on some of the most wonderful highlights whether you're seeking history, nature or fine food and wine. How ever you spend your time, the beauty of the château and surrounding area is breathtaking.

Location & Local Information

Set in over 60 acres of vast grounds featuring fields, forests and a small lake, Château des Lauzes enjoys an incredible location in the heart of the Périgord Noir, between the Vézère and Dordogne rivers. There are walking and mountain biking trails in the estate which lead to other paths in the neighbouring countryside.

Despite this rural location, you are near two villages, the nearest being 3.5km with a couple of good restaurants and a bakery.

The other village, 4km away, is set on the hillside above the Dordogne river. Explore the old town, dating back to the 12th century, wandering around the steep lanes and perhaps stopping off for a coffee in a charming café or a spot of lunch. This medieval village has an interesting history and there is lots of beautiful architecture to admire as well as amazing valley and river views from the top. There's a lovely market on a Sunday morning which shouldn't be missed. There are also supermarkets and shops in a commercial area around the village which are useful amenities to have so close, just a tenminute drive away.

Within ten minutes you can also be on the banks of the Dordogne river, hiring canoes and kayaks or simply sitting by the riverside with a picnic of regional delights picked up from a local market. There are boat trips along the Dordogne river, departing from some of the idyllic riverside villages such as Beynac-et-Cazenac (14km) and La Roque-Gageac (19km).

The Vézère river is also a wonderful spot for canoeing with Le Bugue (12km) just fifteen minutes by car (visit on a Tuesday morning for market day!). Not to mention the amazing pre-historic attractions across the Vézère valley, many of which are UNESCO World Heritage sites. The village of Les Eyzies is only 8km away with its Musée National de Préhistoire.

There are also many fascinating caves in the area to explore - the most famous being pre-historic Lascaux, 30km away, with others even nearer such as the Gouffre de Proumeyssac (10km).


Not to mention the Dordogne's awe-inspiring châteaux, some of which are possible to visit such as Château de Beynac (16km) and Château des Milandes (14km) with its wonderful gardens. Garden lovers should also visit Les Jardins de Marqueyssac (17km) or the incredible Jardins du Manoir d'Eyrignac (33km).

Sarlat-la-Canéda (20km) is known for its beautiful architecture, excellent restaurants and wonderful markets. Some of the France's '*Plus Beaux Villages*' are also nearby such as Domme (24km), Saint-Amand-de-Coly (37km) and Monpazier (35km).

What you should know...

- The three tower bedrooms in the North Wing are accessed via steep and curving turret stairs.
- Indeed, this château offers immense character with lots of steps both inside and out as well as open terraces around the building, some with amazing valley views.
- A maximum of 16 guests are allowed at this chateau. This includes a maximum of 8 children (under 18), and no more than 2 children aged 3 and under.
- The hospitable yet discreet owners live on the estate in a lodge which is out of sight.
- Final guest numbers are required one month before arrival. No additional guests will be allowed unless previously agreed with the owner. Any breach of this rule will result in the guests being asked to leave.

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: €2000 charged to client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.

- Arrival time: 5.00 p.m.
- Departure time: 9.00 a.m.
- Energy costs included?: Yes.
- Linen & towels included?: Yes and changed mid-stay for stays of more than one week.
- Pets welcome?: Not allowed.

- Other Ts and Cs: Stag/hen parties are not permitted. Quiet and non-intrusive owners live in a lodge on the estate, they will be very happy to help. Final guest numbers are required one month before arrival. No additional guests will be allowed unless previously agreed with the owner. Any breach of this rule will result in the guests being asked to leave. A maximum of 16 guests are allowed at this chateau. This includes a maximum of 8 children (under 18), and no more than 2 children aged 3 and under.

- Changeover day: Saturday from June to September. All other changeover days in other periods on request.

- End of stay cleaning available?: Yes and mid-stay clean included for stays of more than one week. Please note guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.

- Smoking Allowed?: No.
