Overview

Set among the terraced vineyards of Portugal's Douro Valley, Quinta do Quirino offers a rare blend of privacy, comfort, and thoughtful design in one of Europe's most historic wine regions. Surrounded by vines first planted in 1756, the estate comprises a spacious main villa and a separate studio, sleeping up to 14 guests across both spaces.

The main house features five beautifully appointed bedrooms, a generous living and dining area, and a fully equipped kitchen made for entertaining. Wide balconies overlook the River Corgo and surrounding valley, while interiors pair natural materials with curated, locally made furnishings to create an understated yet contemporary atmosphere.

The self-contained studio, with its own kitchen, bedroom, and living space, adds flexibility for larger groups or families traveling together.

Quinta do Quirino's hillside setting includes an infinity pool, wine cellar (available for private events outside harvest season), and access to scenic walking routes through the estate's vineyards. Whether you're planning a laid-back retreat or a celebration among friends, the villa offers an inspiring base to experience the region's food, wine, and culture.

Location & Local Information

Quinta do Quirino sits in the heart of the UNESCOprotected Douro Valley, surrounded by vineyard-covered hills and winding river views. It offers a peaceful base just a short drive from Régua - the historic hub of the world's oldest demarcated wine region.

Wine tastings and vineyard visits are a highlight here, particularly for those keen to explore the region's legacy of port production. Nearby miradouros, such as São Leonardo de Galafura, offer sweeping views after scenic hikes. For a slower pace, board the Douro Historical Train for a heritage steam journey through the valley, running June to October.

The easily accessible towns of Vila Real and Lamego add cultural depth, with baroque mansions, Gothic cathedrals, and even sparkling wine cellars to discover. Dining in the region leans into hearty, traditional fare - don't leave without trying feijoada à transmontana, a rich local stew rooted in generations of hillside cooking.

Terms & Conditions

- Security deposit: 500€ charged to the client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to a full inspection.
- Arrival time: 3pm 8pm
- Departure time: 11am
- Energy costs included?: Yes, included in rental price.
