Location & Local Information

Oak Tree Cottage enjoys a private, secluded location just five minutes from Dunkeld, a picturesque Perthshire town on the River Tay. Dunkeld is steeped in history, with charming early 1700s houses restored by the National Trust for Scotland, an ancient cathedral, and the famous Dunkeld Bridge, built by Thomas Telford in 1809. Across the river, Birnam adds to the area's allure with stunning countryside, rich heritage, and delightful eateries. Known as "Big Tree Country," the Dunkeld House Tree Trail offers serene woodland walks through the Dunkeld House Estate, once home to the "Planting Dukes" of Atholl.

Nearby, The Hermitage offers a breathtaking landscape of towering Douglas firs, the dramatic Black Linn Falls, and Ossian's Hall, a restored 18th-century folly overlooking the cascade. Nature lovers can enjoy spotting red squirrels and salmon while exploring the forest trails. Further afield, Pitlochry offers vibrant culture, including shows at the Festival Theatre, Highland games, and the Enchanted Forest, along with spas, craft shops, and local dining.

Blair Castle, home to the Atholl family for over seven centuries, features stunning interiors, a walled garden, a red deer park, and roaming peacocks. Nearby, the Blair Athol Distillery offers tours and tastings of its renowned whisky, making it a must-visit for enthusiasts.
