Visitors can explore landmarks such as St Andrews Cathedral and Castle, enjoy fine dining, and indulge in local ice creams.

For golfers, St Andrews is a dream, with prestigious courses like the Castle Course, the Old Course, the New Course, the Jubilee Course, the Eden Course and the Strathyrum Course available to play. History enthusiasts can visit Scotland's Secret Bunker, climb St Rule's Tower for panoramic views, or join a St Andrews Ghost Tour to discover haunted sites. The Fife Pilgrim Way is a scenic route that takes walkers through the historic Kingdom of Fife, once a significant pilgrimage destination.

A short drive away, Dundee offers a wealth of cultural experiences. Visitors can explore the RRS Discovery, Captain Scott's Antarctic ship, and HM Frigate Unicorn, a 19th-century warship, as well as museums like Verdant Works and The McManus Art Gallery.
