

Villa Kobalt

Overview

Set in the historic village of Vrbanj, Villa Kobalt is a beautifully restored 19th-century home that offers an authentic stay in the heart of Hvar. Surrounded by centuries-old stone buildings, including landmarks dating back to the 15th century, the villa places guests within easy reach of local shops, a traditional restaurant, and cultural highlights. The coastal village of Vrboska, known for its charming bridges and waterfront setting, is just 4km away, while Jelsa, Stari Grad and lively Hvar Town are all within a short drive.

Designed for up to six guests, with the option to accommodate two more on sofa beds, the villa combines original architectural features with clean, contemporary interiors. Exposed stone walls and wooden beams add character, while the open-plan living space feels bright and sociable. A sleek, fully equipped kitchen sits alongside a comfortable lounge area, with large doors leading out to a covered dining terrace, private pool and sun deck.

Outside, the enclosed terrace provides a peaceful setting for long lunches and relaxed afternoons, while inside, three well-appointed bedrooms each come with their own bathroom, finished with modern fittings. Villa Kobalt offers a thoughtful balance of heritage and comfort, ideal for those looking to experience a more traditional side of the island without compromising on style.

Location & Local Information

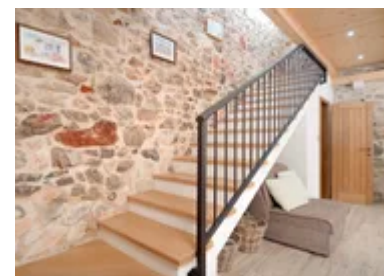
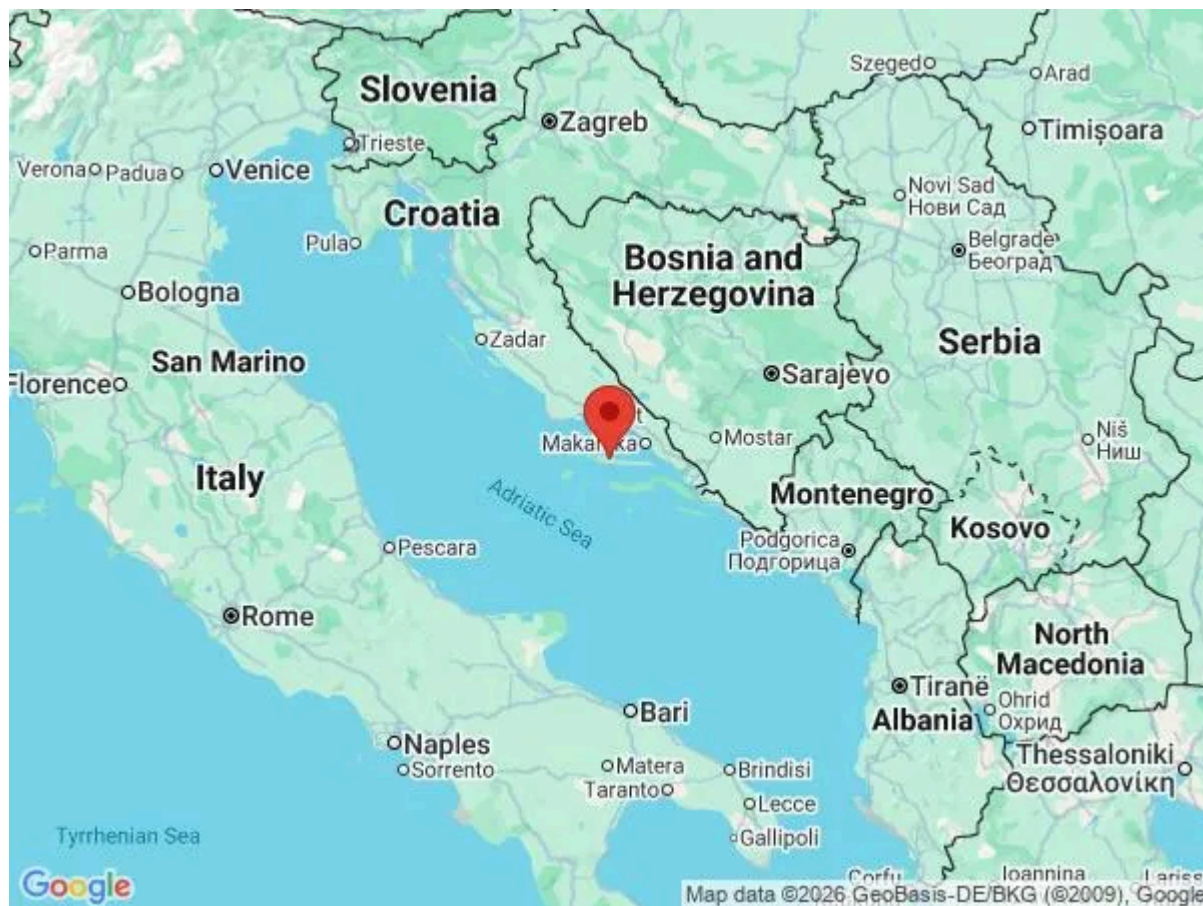
Located in the village of Vrbanj, close to Stari Grad and the UNESCO-listed Stari Grad Plain, the villa offers a well-positioned base for exploring Hvar's cultural and natural highlights. Historically, Vrbanj developed as a sheltered inland settlement, with fortifications dating back to the 16th and 17th centuries. Today, it remains a lived-in village with a handful of cafés, local shops, a post office and a respected restaurant, alongside a wine centre that reflects the island's long-standing viticultural traditions. The village square is home to Kraljev dvor, a medieval residence, and a parish church that continues to play a central role in local life. Nearby villages such as Pitve and Vrisnik are also worth visiting for their well-regarded, traditional dining spots.

The surrounding Stari Grad Plain, known locally as Ager or Hora, is one of the island's most significant landscapes, best explored by bike or on foot. Stone walls, olive groves and vineyards stretch across the plain, offering a clear sense of Hvar's agricultural heritage. For wider views, the island's highest point, St Nicholas peak, rewards those willing to hike.

Jelsa, a short drive away, offers beaches, waterfront cafés and a wider selection of restaurants, while Stari Grad combines historical interest with a relaxed harbour setting. For a livelier atmosphere, Hvar Town is around 23km away, known for its historic architecture, busy marina and evening scene.
