Overview

This splendid villa with captivating vistas over the wooded slopes is in a tranquil location just beyond the picturesque town of Caminha. The generously proportioned villa is tastefully and elegantly adorned, adhering to the highest standards. The lodging offers a sense of spaciousness, with an open and breezy ambience pervading the villa. Meticulously selected furnishings ensure both comfort and aesthetic harmony. The living and dining area boasts a view of a stunning terrace, partially sheltered to accommodate outdoor dining. Immerse yourself in the refreshing waters of the secluded, panoramic swimming pool, and relish the scenery from the terrace while sipping a refreshing glass of Vinho Verde.

Though nestled in the countryside, essential amenities are conveniently situated nearby. The village's local shop is a mere 2 km away. Caminha, an enchanting town exuding 15th and 16th-century architectural charm, lies approximately 4 km distant. Ventures across the border to Spain are easily attainable from Caminha, facilitated by a ferry that traverses the River Minho. For sandy shores, a short car ride leads to Moledo and Afife beaches. Opting for the train is also viable, given the train station in Caminha, which even offers complimentary parking. Various sporting activities, including horse riding, rafting, and canoeing, are accessible quickly. Moreover, an excellent 18-hole golf course nestles within the hills just outside the historical town of Ponte de Lima, a leisurely 40-minute drive away.

A door leads to the garden and barbecue area. Furthermore, a double bedroom inclusive of an ensuite bathroom. Lastly, a bedroom furnished with two single beds and another room with a double bed, sharing a common bathroom.

The property boasts an expansive, well-maintained garden, as well as a sunbathing terrace and a lush lawn. An exceptional barbecue area beckons for al fresco dining. The private swimming pool, measuring 8m X 4m with a depth ranging from 1.2m to 1.4m, is perfect for a revitalizing dip.

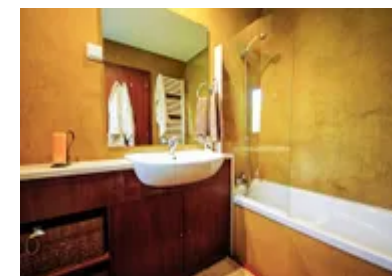
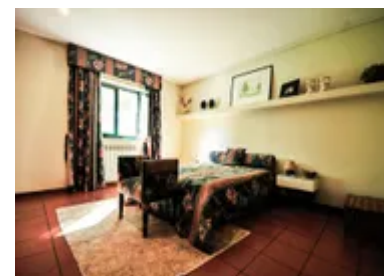
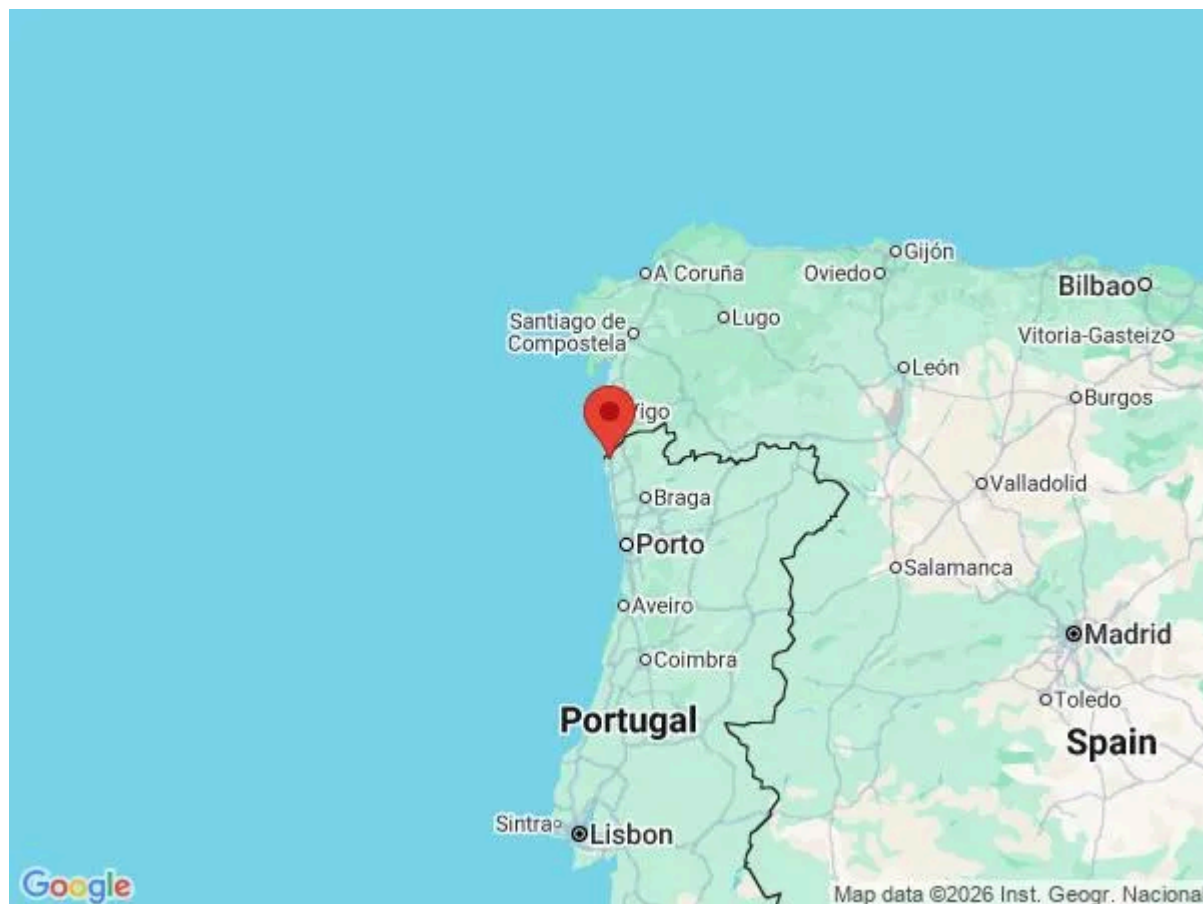


Location & Local Information

Casa Venade is a delightful villa, nestled in the lush countryside just outside the historic town of Caminha and close to some wonderful Minho beaches. Caminha is located near the mouth of the River Minho which separates Portugal and Spain. This ancient, characterful town boasts many historical buildings including the 12th century national monument, Torre do Relógio de Caminha. This is the clock tower which forms part of the old city walls. You can climb to the top of the tower to enjoy fabulous panoramic views of the town. The lively main town square, the Praça Conselheiro Silva Torres, boasts many cafes and restaurants and an interesting fountain which used to supply drinking water for the town. The 16th century Igreja da Misericórdia was once a hospital and hostel for pilgrims travelling to Santiago de Compostela. The grandest church is the Igreja Matriz at the end of Rua Direita. It boasts some incredible tiles from the seventeenth century. The ruins of the Fort of Insua stand on a tiny island in the middle of the estuary, originally built in the fifteenth century to defend the entrance to the river. The island was inhabited by monks from the 14th century.

There are some excellent beaches close by, including Foz do Minho Beach which is located next to the River Minho, a wonderful area of magnificent natural beauty, fine golden sands and delightful walking trails. Just around the corner is another sandy wonder, Praia do Camarido followed by Praia de Moledo and Vila Praia de Ancora.

Day trip options from Casa Venade include trips to Spain. A ferry connects the two banks of the River Minho plus there are bridges further along the river. The delightful town of Tui can be found on the northern side of the Minho River, in Galicia. It boasts a beautiful historic centre and an excellent range of gourmet dining as well as excellent shops. Tui is located south of the Pontevedra province sitting opposite the Portuguese town of Valença. The towns are connected by a nineteenth century bridge. Valença do Minho is located on the hillside overlooking the left bank of the Minho and on the main road that links the Spanish Santiago de Compostela with Porto. Tourists



flock to the town to buy embroidered tablecloths and sheets, the speciality of the town.

Casa Venade's surrounding countryside and rivers are fabulous, brimming with Camarido pine trees and picturesque walking trails. Miardouro da Fraga is an astonishing viewpoint with stunning views of the Minho River and the surrounding landscape. Another excellent viewpoint is at Santo Antao. The Serra D'Arga Mountain offers sensational vistas as well as beautiful natural lagoons and waterfalls which eventually lead to the golden sands of Vila Praia de Ancora. Visitors can also enjoy horse riding, rafting and canoeing and golf on an excellent 18-hole course nestled in the hills outside the Roman town of Ponte de Lima, roughly 40 minutes drive away.

Ponte de Lima is one of the most characterful and picturesque towns of Northern Portugal. It sits on the southern banks of the Lima River. The location has been the main river crossing since the Romans constructed a bridge in 1AD. There is a delightful array of ancient houses, grand religious buildings, pretty plazas and museums. There are also a number of colourful flower gardens and the town is surrounded with beautiful natural scenery. Ponte de Lima is an excellent centre for adventure activities such as the Ecovia cycling route, kayaking along the Lima River, mountain biking or hiking in the Serra D'Arga or birdwatching in the Lagoas de Bertandos. You can river bathe in Labruja.

Further south, Braga is regarded as one the main religious centres of Portugal, with the oldest cathedral and many Gothic churches. Every hour you will hear a cocophony of different church bells ringing out! It is the third largest city of Portugal and is a joy to explore. Braga is an enthralling university city and the setting for Bom Jesus do Monte, a fine monument. The historic centre is fully pedestrianised. There are pretty city gardens, charming plazas and busy shopping streets.
