The nearby Skala Eresou, a lively beach town, adds vibrant cafes, restaurants, shops, and one of Lesvos' finest sandy stretches to the experience.

Once an elegant 19th-century mansion, Alexis House has been beautifully restored to combine period charm with modern luxury. The property comprises two buildings: one with four sumptuous bedroom suites, a dining room, and lounge; the other dedicated to a superb private spa. Each suite has its own character, from the romantic Elpida Suite with soaring ceilings to the light-filled Niki Suite with sweeping sea views. All come with luxurious bathrooms, quality mattresses, and thoughtful amenities.

Guests enjoy hotel-style services including daily housekeeping, turndown service, and gourmet breakfasts. The villa features an outdoor pool, alfresco dining terraces, and panoramic views of the valley, mountains, and Aegean. With its spa hammam, indoor pool, and optional private chef, Alexis House is a haven for wellness, indulgence, and relaxation.



Location & Local Information



Eressos is tranquil, authentic, away from crowds. On the southwest coast of Lesvos, is one of the island's most atmospheric villages, perched above a lush green valley with sweeping views of mountains and sea. Wandering its streets feels like stepping back in time, with ancient stone houses, children playing outside, and a pace of life unchanged for generations. A handful of Taverns and a bakery are just around the corner. Just 3km away lies Skala Eresou, birthplace of the poetess Sappho, home to one of Lesvos' best Blue Flag beaches. Here, long golden sands meet crystal waters, lined with bamboo-decked cafés, waterfront tavernas and a relaxed, spiritual vibe.

The surrounding valley is alive with wildlife, spring-fed lakes, orchards, ruins and walking trails. A short drive brings you to the island's unique Petrified Forest, while across Lesvos you'll find medieval castles, hot springs, charming villages, monasteries and fascinating museums—including the world-famous Ouzo Museum. The island is also a paradise for birdwatchers in spring, when migratory species flood the salt lakes of Kalloni, and for beach lovers with over 20 stretches of coastline, from secluded coves to vast sandy bays like Vatera.

Lesvos remains unspoilt by mass tourism—authentic, rugged, and full of history. It's Greece as it used to be, where natural beauty, tradition and hospitality come together in timeless harmony.

What you should know...

- The adjacent spa and hammam is open to the public, but has a separate access. Alexis House client are offered treatments with a 10% discount. The staff kitchen is also housed in this building. Alternatively you can book to have the spa building exclusively, see T&C's.
- Guests staying will enjoy a daily housekeeping service, nightly turndown, room refreshments and delicious breakfasts. You can choose to pay for a private chef plus you can choose to dine alfresco or in the dining room
- In Sappho suite a door separates the twin from the double bed.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** There is no security deposit, but should there be any damage or loss caused by you or your guests during your stay you will be liable for the cost
- **Arrival time:** 4pm onwards
- **Departure time:** 10am, or before
- **Energy costs included?**: Yes
- **Linen & towels included?**: Yes, including pool towels. Linen and towels changed twice a week.
- **Pets welcome?**: No
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Stay includes complimentary Self-Service Hammam & Indoor Pool access by appointment up to 1h per day. Traditional hammam - with a ketsea and soap massage lasting approx 1 hr can be booked at a cost of €30 per person. Other Spa services are available with a 10% discount on the usual price.
- **End of stay cleaning available?**: Yes, and daily light cleaning. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?**: Not permitted
- **Other 3:** For exclusive use of the spa block including the living room with real fire there is an additional cost, this includes unlimited use of the hammam and indoor pool on a self service basis. Any spa treatments will be charged as extra with a 20% discount on public rates High Season: 22/07-24/09 €400 per night Mid Season: 10/06-21/07 €300 per night Low Season: 01/05-09/06 & 25/09-31/10 €250 per night
- **Minimum stay:** No minimum stay
- **Heating costs included?**: Yes
- **Internet access?**: Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access included in rental price. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

The Greek government requires owners to collect a Tourist Climate Tax, your property manager will collect this in cash:

March-October €15 per night per unit

November-February €4 per night per unit
