Overview

At Cairngorms Castle, this vision is elevated into a refined, fully serviced experience where every detail is impeccably arranged. Set within a two hundred acre private estate on the southern fringe of the Cairngorms National Park, this distinguished Victorian castle offers an exceptional setting to relax, entertain and create lasting memories, all supported by a dedicated team and discreet, attentive service.

Steeped in history, the estate dates back to the eighteenth century, with the present castle built in the early eighteen sixties for Lord Clyde, Queen Victoria's banker, and designed by her Balmoral architect. Today, guests are free to explore rivers, a private loch and surrounding glens, with fishing, walking and Highland pursuits effortlessly arranged by your private butler, who curates each stay with precision and care.

Inside, elegant interiors unfold across generous reception rooms including a traditional library, a drawing room with roaring fires, and a formal dining room seating up to twenty guests. A relaxed breakfast room adjoins a well-equipped kitchen, while ten beautifully appointed bedrooms, including a four poster master suite, offer comfort and privacy. Dining is a highlight, with bespoke menus featuring breakfast, lunch or afternoon tea and a three course dinner with canapés, all delivered with seamless daily service and complemented by a memorable Scottish piper experience.

Location & Local Information

The magnificent Cairngorms Castle is set in the heart of Glenshee, an exceptionally scenic Highland glen, where its elevated position above the meadows of Shee Water reveals far-reaching mountain views and crisp, fresh air. Located on the southern fringe of the Cairngorms National Park, and within two hours of Edinburgh and Glasgow, this peaceful setting, known locally as 'the fairy glen', provides a remarkable backdrop for a fully serviced stay. With a private butler on hand, guests can effortlessly access a wide range of activities including walking, angling, shooting, golf, cycling and winter sports, all thoughtfully arranged to suit individual preferences.

The surrounding landscape is truly striking. The sixty four mile Catearan Trail passes through the estate, offering panoramic views across rugged peaks and verdant glens, while the wider national park presents scenic drives and fifty five Munros to explore. Kayaking and canoeing can also be organised, with instructor-led sessions available for beginners.

Golf enthusiasts are well catered for, with over one hundred courses nearby, including Braemar, as well as championship and world-renowned courses within easy reach. On the estate, guests enjoy access to a private stretch of the River Shee for salmon and trout fishing, along with a loch for rainbow and brown trout.

Beyond the estate, a wealth of renowned Highland experiences are within easy reach. The celebrated Fife Arms in Braemar, just fifteen minutes away, offers exceptional dining and drinks in a distinctive art-led setting. The Fish Shop in Ballater, approximately one hour's drive, holds Michelin Bib Gourmand recognition and is known for its refined approach to freshly delivered seafood. Balmoral Castle, the late Queen's Highland residence, lies around forty five minutes away, with its gardens and selected interiors open to visitors. For shopping, the House of Bruar, around fifty minutes from the estate, offers an extensive selection of Scottish country attire, alongside a well-regarded food hall and restaurant. All excursions can be seamlessly arranged, ensuring a refined and highly personalised Highlands experience throughout.
