

Villa Lagomandra

Overview

Situated right beside the ocean, Villa Lagomandra sits in beautiful Mediterranean gardens. With room for up to 10 guests, this ultra-modern villa in Halkidiki incorporates impressive living spaces and features a 120 sq m infinity pool with gorgeous sea views.

This wonderful beachside getaway really will blow you away. Offering access to a private beach, Villa Lagomandra boasts outdoor areas that are both spacious and charming, including a poolside terrace with seating, and a lovely outdoor dining area and kitchen with barbecue. Sun loungers line up on the front lawn, while a roof terrace offers day beds and the most incredible panoramas – you can watch the sun set over Mount Olympus or look up at the stars late at night.

Architecturally impressive, the main building has large, sliding glass doors, allowing natural light to flood inside. A modern living area leads you to a well-equipped kitchen which has its own convenient access to the outside dining space.

There's a lot more to discover on the basement level, where there is a gym and a spa with sauna and hammam. You can watch all your favourite movies in the cinema room which is also downstairs, or make use of the open-air cinema with its comfy seating.

The villa has three bedrooms in the main building, and another two in a separate, self-contained basement apartment. On the first floor of the villa, the master bedroom has a king-size bed, dressing room and an en suite bathroom, as well as two balconies, a roof garden and hot tub. Two more en suite double bedrooms enjoy access to the terrace. Hotel-style amenities like Nespresso machines and mini-bars add extra to these



already exquisite rooms.

The apartment is ideal for younger guests who want a space of their own. There are two bedrooms which share a bathroom, as well as living area with Smart TV and PlayStation, and a kitchenette and laundry room.

Situated on the Sithonia Peninsula, Villa Lagomandra enjoys access to the area's numerous beaches, mountains and beautiful areas of forest. Within a 15-minute drive you can visit the village of Nikiti or the larger town of Neos Marmaras.

Location & Local Information

Hugely popular with visitors, Halkidiki is divided into three peninsulas – Cassandra, Sithonia and Athos – which jut out into the Aegean Sea. With verdant countryside, tempting sandy beaches and an array of historic sights, there's quite a bit to see around the region, which is easily accessible from Thessaloniki Airport, situated to the north west.



Of the three peninsulas, Cassandra is the most developed for tourism, with plenty of resorts, while Sithonia is quieter and good for nature lovers. Mount Athos is home to an area of 20 monasteries which is complicated to visit (and, indeed, women are not allowed to), but you may like to take a cruise to view it from a distance.

Certainly an impressive sight, you can sail from the resort of Ouranoupolis, to the north of Mount Athos, where you will also find the 14th-century Prosforio Tower. This Byzantine structure was apparently built by monks from Athos to defend the area from invasion. Well preserved, and subject to many renovations over the years, it's a significant local landmark.

Another popular attraction is the impressive Petrolena Cave with its impressive stalactites and stalagmites. You may also wish to visit Petrolena's Anthropological Museum, where findings from the cave are on display.

Lovers of archaeology can visit sites such as Olynthos. Located north east of the village which shares its name, this site dates back to the 7th century, and more recent excavations have uncovered some of the oldest known mosaic floors in all of Greece. Artefacts from this site can also be found at a local museum in the village. This is just one of many archaeological sites found around the Halkidiki peninsulas, with the remains of ancient cities such as Acanthus and Stagira also well worth a visit.

You can appreciate the area's natural beauty at the Lake of Polychrono, on the western side of Cassandra. One attraction of this pretty nature reserve is the chance to



see the Testudinata turtles. You will also find a sandy beach there.

In the village of Stagira you can visit a park dedicated to philosopher Aristotle, as this was his birthplace. Aristotle Park also contains an array of instruments, such as a solar clock and water turbine which demonstrate the power of nature.

The region as a whole offers a wide array of places to eat and drink, with village tavernas and beach bars commonplace, alongside high-end restaurants. You can get to know more about the area's wine production by taking a winery tour. For a taste of local culture, there are also several annual festivals, with summer's Sani Festival and Cassandra Festival among those covering art, music and theatre.
