The chalet is available year-round, but facilities, property and local amenities may vary depending upon season.



### **Location & Local Information**

Nestled within the breathtaking Chamonix Valley, Chalet Coccinelle offers an exceptional retreat perfectly positioned to embrace the extraordinary skiing terrain that has made this region a sought-after destination in Europe. The Les Grands Montets ski slopes, renowned for their spectacular pistes and off-piste challenges, attract visitors from around the globe, creating a vibrant and dynamic atmosphere.

During the winter months, Les Grands Montets showcases its three distinctive zones, each offering a unique skiing experience. The lower mountain area, extending between Argentière Village and the Lognan main station at 1972m, provides a diverse range of slopes. Moving upwards, the mixed alpine terrain from Lognan to Borchard at 2765m caters to intermediate skiers, while the steeper alpine terrain, including the Argentière glacier up to 3275m, beckons to the bold and adventurous.

Much of the skiing terrain is situated above the tree line, and the upper areas, accessible by a second cable car, offer a panoramic view that is nothing short of breathtaking. From the top lift station, visitors can marvel at the Argentière glacier and the majestic Mont Dolent in the distance. With 8 main lifts, including 2 gondolas, 2 cable cars, and 4 chair lifts, Les Grands Montets provides access to a world-class skiing experience.

However, Chamonix is not only a winter paradise but a fully functioning yearround resort. During the summer, the Chamonix Valley transforms into a haven for outdoor enthusiasts. The area boasts stunning landscapes, icefalls, waterfalls, and numerous paths for exploration on foot or mountain bike. Les Grands Montets continues to offer fabulous scenery, making it an ideal destination throughout the year.

Beyond the exhilarating skiing and outdoor activities, Chamonix offers thrilling attractions for all seasons. The Aiguille du Midi Skywalk, known as the "Step into the Void," is a glass room suspended at a staggering 12,604 feet (3,842 meters), providing unparalleled views of Europe's highest peaks. For those seeking a different thrill, tandem paragliding flights from a 3220m altitude offer an adrenaline-pumping experience.

Argentière, a charming and authentic village within the valley, serves as an ideal base. Besides the excellent skiing school and local amenities, the village offers fantastic hiking paths, including a climb to Lac Blanc for stunning views of Mont Blanc.

Chamonix town, a mere 10 minutes' drive away, adds to the allure with its lively atmosphere. In both summer and winter, it provides an array of shops, bars, and restaurants, making it a perfect destination for a day or night out. The pedestrianized town center comes alive in the evenings, and the renowned apres-ski scene ensures that Chamonix remains a picturesque and vibrant destination at the crossroads of France, Italy, and Switzerland.
