

Villa Cesur

Overview

Villa Cesur is a contemporary three-bedroom, three-bathroom retreat set within the peaceful village of Ovacik, with sweeping views across the Taurus Mountains. Designed for year-round escapes, the villa accommodates up to four guests and is ideal for families or friends seeking a stylish and tranquil base in the Turkish countryside.

The property sits within secluded, mature gardens and offers both indoor and outdoor swimming pools, ideal for any season, with indoor pool heating included from October to March. The two-storey villa combines clean-lined architecture with floor-to-ceiling glass that floods the interiors with natural light and frames the mountain vistas. Inside, a palette of crisp whites, natural wood, and accents of Mediterranean blue creates a serene, modern feel.

The open-plan living area features a spacious lounge, a fully equipped American-style kitchen, and a dining space for six. Entertainment includes a flat-screen TV, DVD player, and satellite channels, with a pool table by the fireplace for winter evenings. On the ground floor, there is a double bedroom with an ensuite and upstairs, the master bedroom boasts a round bed and jacuzzi bath overlooking the countryside, while the twin bedroom also enjoys its own balcony and ensuite.

Outdoors, guests can relax on sun loungers beside the main pool, unwind in the hammock, or enjoy games of table tennis and outdoor billiards. Alfresco dining is encouraged with a rattan table, a barbecue, and a shaded pergola lounge perfect for lazy afternoons or starlit evenings.

Location & Local Information

Villa Cesur is set in the mountains of Ovacik village, just forty-five minutes by car (around fifty kilometres) from Dalaman International Airport. Ideally positioned between the vibrant town of Fethiye and the popular resorts of Hisaronu and Oludeniz, both only fifteen minutes away, it offers excellent access to local attractions. Shops and restaurants are a short three hundred metre stroll from the villa, with Hisaronu offering a lively mix of supermarkets, cafés, bars, restaurants, and souvenir shops.


Oludeniz, famous for its golden sandy beach and iconic lagoon, is a must-visit. Enjoy seafront dining, boutique shopping, or take a boat trip to Butterfly Valley or Gemile Island, a protected open-air museum. Adventurers can ride the cable car up Mount Babadag and paraglide from nearly two thousand metres above sea level, landing on the shores of Oludeniz.

Fethiye, a harbour town steeped in history, features a Roman amphitheatre, ancient rock tombs, a museum, and is the departure point for the renowned Twelve Island boat tour. It's fish market, bustling Tuesday market, and waterfront promenade to Calis Beach offer something for everyone.

For history lovers, the region is rich in ancient Lycian sites. Explore Xanthos, Patara, Tlos, Letoon, and Pinara, each with its own archaeological wonders. Round off your journey at Fethiye Museum, home to the multilingual Trilingual Stele and a wealth of local artefacts.

What you should know...

- There is an extra heating charge for the heated pool
- Bathroom towels are provided, but please can you bring your own beach towels – don't worry if you forget, Turkey is known for its fabulous selection of inexpensive and fun towels for every occasion, pick some up in the local market and maybe extra to take home with you.
- The villa can be hired all year round, but is on a Monday-to-Monday rental, most of the airlines now offer start of the week flights

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** £200 (or equivalent in lira, euro, dollars) paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4.00 p.m.
- **Departure time:** 10.00 a.m.
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, included in the rental price.
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes, included in the rental price. Please bring your own pool towels.
- **Pets welcome?:** Not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Changeover day:** Monday
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Smoking & vaping are not permitted.
- **Other 2:** In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- **Other 3:** Sauna can be used for £200 extra per week
- **Minimum stay:** 7 nights
- **Heating costs included?:** Yes, included in the rental price.
- **Pool heating charge?:** There is an additional charge of £250 per week (paid locally), please request at time of booking
- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
