

La Ferme De Pierre

Region: Provence-Alpes **Sleeps:** 10

Overview

Sitting just 1km outside the quaint village of Verquières, near the foothills of the Alpilles, La Ferme de Pierre is a charming six-bedroom farmhouse ideal for a French escape with friends or family.

From the outside, it retains its traditional character with stone walls, shutters and terracotta tiles, while inside period features such as beams and fireplaces blend with elegant, modern comforts. The ground floor offers a bright open-plan living and dining area opening onto the garden, plus a fully equipped kitchen creating a sociable space for everyone to gather.

Four double bedrooms with air conditioning are on the first floor (one with adjacent TV lounge, perfect for teens or guests wanting extra privacy), while two further doubles on the second floor overlook the leafy grounds. Some beds can be converted to twins on request.

Outside, the 3600m² garden is made for outdoor living, with a summer kitchen for al-fresco dining, a private pool, ancient trees for shade, plus boules and table tennis.

Nearby villages include Verquières (1km), Saint-Andiol (4km), Eyragues (8km) and Châteaurenard (10km), while Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (12km) and Avignon are within easy driving distance for history, culture, markets and riverside strolls. The surrounding Provençal countryside is perfect for walking, cycling, horse riding and golf.

Location & Local Information

La Ferme de Pierre is a peaceful retreat in the heart of Provence, surrounded by mountains, lavender fields, vineyards and historic villages. There is plenty to see and do nearby, so you can enjoy art, culture and local cuisine without long drives.

Just 1km away, Verquières is the nearest village, with a pretty church, medieval dovecote and quiet streets for a gentle stroll. From here, walking paths wind through orchards and farmland, and local roads lead to cycling routes with superb views.

The region is dotted with charming villages and small towns. Eyragues (8km) has a lively Friday market selling fresh local produce, as well as cafés, restaurants and sites such as Saint-Bonnet Chapel with its gardens and old tombs. In summer you'll find festivals and village events, while winter brings Christmas markets.

Châteaurenard (under 10km) is another characterful spot, crowned by its ruined castle with towers you can still explore and an exhibition on its turbulent history. The town also offers a museum of agricultural tools, plus plenty of shops, cafés, restaurants and a large market.

For a larger town with real cultural depth, Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (12km) is a must. Visit the 11th-century Saint-Paul-de-Mausole monastery, where Van Gogh stayed and painted many works, then explore the nearby Roman ruins of Glanum. Saint-Rémy itself is full of pretty squares, boutiques and inviting places to eat.
