

Villa Petro

Overview

Discover Villa Petro, located near Porto Heli on the Argolic Gulf in southeastern Greece. This expansive villa boasts eight bedrooms and five bathrooms spread across three floors, accommodating up to fourteen guests comfortably, perfect for large gatherings of family or friends.

Crafted from local stone in a classical style, Villa Petro features natural shady porticoes, stylish terraces, and balconies with stunning sea views. Set within its spacious grounds, including two walled gardens for privacy, the villa is elegantly illuminated at night. The grounds also include a well-manicured garden with mature trees and shrubs, a large private swimming pool, and a pathway leading to a potager garden supplying seasonal fruits and vegetables.

Ample private parking, complimentary Wi-Fi, and air conditioning throughout ensure convenience and comfort. The interior is tastefully furnished with handcrafted wooden furniture and decorated in a neutral palette with vibrant accents. While the exterior presents a grand architectural presence, the interior offers a warm and inviting atmosphere, akin to a true holiday retreat.

Inside, guests are welcomed by a parquet hallway leading to a spacious open-plan living area with floor-to-ceiling windows, comfortable sofas, and a flat-screen TV. The adjacent farmhouse-style dining area is ideal for indoor entertaining. The large traditional kitchen is fully equipped with modern amenities, including a built-in oven, microwave, and family-sized fridge.

A marble staircase leads to the first floor, where four bedrooms offer scenic views and comfortable accommodations. The master bedroom features a king-size bed and ensuite bathroom, while the remaining



bedrooms share well-appointed facilities. The basement houses four additional bedrooms, each with natural light and ventilation, alongside a comfortable sitting room and a second kitchen.

Outside, guests can enjoy the lush green gardens, paved terrace, and ladder-entry private swimming pool. White cushioned sun loungers and shady parasols surround the pool, inviting relaxation. An outdoor seating area under a straw-roofed pergola offers a tranquil spot for reading or enjoying cocktails prepared at the nearby mini bar. Alfresco dining is a delight with fresh produce from the potager and a choice of gas or charcoal rotisserie.

Just a short walk from a sandy beach, Villa Petro promises an idyllic setting for creating lasting holiday memories.


Location & Local Information

Villa Petro is situated along the coast of Petrothalassa, near the picturesque harbour of Porto Heli, offering impressive sea views of Trikeri, Spetses, and Dokos islands. The closest international airport is Athens, with travel to Porto Heli conveniently accessible via ferry from Piraeus harbour followed by a short taxi ride to the villa or if you are driving down by car or taxi, the route for Spetses takes you to the coast of Costa and is about a 3 hour drive. Nestled in a secluded residential bay, Villa Petro faces the shoreline amidst a small cluster of similar luxury residences. The nearest beach is just steps away from the villa.

Local shops for essentials are located approximately two and a half kilometres away, offering opportunities to enjoy local bars for ouzo or traditional tavernas for meze. Porto Heli, a summer resort located three kilometres down the road, provides ferry connections to Spetses, Hydra, and Poros islands. Visitors can explore Porto Heli's cosmopolitan atmosphere, featuring upscale shops, local arts and crafts, waterfront dining, and relaxed cafes ideal for people-watching. Evenings can be spent under the stars at the town's open-air cinema.

For those seeking adventure, organized beaches nearby offer water sports such as jet skiing and horseback riding along the Aegean Sea. Lake Ververoda, known for its purported medicinal properties and hosting international water-skiing competitions, invites swimming and fishing. Boat trips offer opportunities for sunbathing, swimming, and snorkelling, either aboard chartered yachts or group tours.

Nature enthusiasts can enjoy scenic walks or hikes along the dramatic coastline, exploring local flora and fauna. From the harbour at Costa, ferries depart for Spetses, a car-free ancient island rich in history dating back to 8000 BC. Spetses offers exploration by horse-drawn carriage, bicycle, motorcycle, or taxi, visiting secret bays, Bekiris cave, Vrelos sandy beach, and the Bouboulina Museum. Further island hopping from Costa includes Hydra, Poros,



and Ermioni, each offering ancient Greek ruins and cultural experiences.

- Villa Petro is quite secluded, the nearest village is a walkable two and a half kilometres away, to make the most of your holiday you may wish to consider hiring a car
- The bedrooms are large and simply furnished, functional rather than decorative
- Pets may be accommodated on request
- The nearest Airport to Spetses is in Athens where you can either take the ferry from Piraeus Port which is a 1hr 55 minute Journey or if you are driving down by car or taxi, the route for Spetses takes you to the coast of Costa and is about a 3 hour drive.
