

Villa Thalassis

Overview

Located just 2km from the closest beach and 4km from the bustling port town of Saint-Tropez, you will find Villa Thalassis. The home is managed by a luxury hotel close by, yet it is situated within its own private grounds.

As you enter the villa's gated grounds, you will be struck by the clean lines and high-quality finish of this large family home. On the ground floor, you will find a large open-plan room with a chic living space and dining area. The fully-fitted kitchen is also located in this area which creates a sociable space for cooking and dining together in the evenings. You could choose to eat indoors, or when the weather is nice, there is also a well-equipped summer kitchen in the garden to dine al-fresco.

After a busy day, there are five bedrooms you can retire to and unwind. Each room is bright and airy, with comfy beds, TVs and en-suite bathrooms, some with bathtubs and others with inviting walk-in showers. The garden here is as gorgeous as the house itself, and the well-planned design continues outdoors. Whether taking a dip in the private, heated pool or reading on the balcony, you will be encircled by trees and incredible views over the Gulf of Saint-Tropez.

There are also a number of small villages and, of course, the centre of Saint-Tropez only 4km away for when you wish to go out for dinner or pick up some groceries. This picture-postcard town boasts a fantastic range of designer shops, cafes, bars and restaurants.

Situated 4km inland on the Saint-Tropez peninsula, Villa Thalassis enjoys a fantastic location with beaches and Saint-Tropez town to one side and pretty hilltop villages and vineyards to the other. From this location, you can explore the diversity of the French Riviera.


Most people visit this area to visit the gorgeous coastline, which is only 2km away! The closest beach is a small cove that is part sand, part pebbled and a lovely spot for a lazy afternoon in the sun enjoying the views. If you are feeling more adventurous, there is also a sailing school on this beach offering private or group sailing classes, catamaran rides and kayak hire. Whether you like a chic beach club with a bar or are looking for a natural windswept bay, you will find it close to the villa! Plus, if you would like to visit Pampelonne beach, one of the longest and most popular in the area, it is just 8km away.

The town has everything you could need on holiday; there is a lively port, fantastic shopping and restaurants, a huge range of beaches and a charming old town. In the old town, you can spend the afternoon wandering around the maze-like streets where you can discover the citadel, ancient churches and a modern art gallery.

If you would like to head out for the day, a great thing to do is take a boat trip from Saint-Tropez port to Les Isles d'Or or the Golden islands. This delightful group of islands have unrivalled beaches and areas protected by national parks. There are three islands to choose from, or you could do a full-day tour and see all three, which lend themselves to cycling, hiking and diving in the crystal-clear waters.
