

# Farmhouse Lazuline

Region: Normandy Sleeps: 8

## Overview

In the peaceful rural countryside of Normandy, Farmhouse Lazuline offers a charming and comfortable place to spend time with loved ones.

Dating back to the 19th century, this characterful bolthole was once the old stables of neighbouring Château Lazuline (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/chateau-lazuline/>). Nowadays, it's a quiet, French retreat which has been recently renovated to provide living space for up to 8 guests across its four pretty bedrooms. Guests can appreciate its heritage with exposed wood beams, rustic flooring and 17th-century antique furnishings, creating a historic yet warm ambience for a family or small group of friends.

Its living spaces will enchant you, especially the gorgeously tiled kitchen and lovely dining area, whilst the contemporary conservatory adds extra space at any time of year. The two acres of garden are glorious with ancient trees, some of which date back over four centuries. It's the perfect place for quiet reading, barbecues in the sunshine and lawn games with children in the private grounds.

This is the ideal base for exploring Normandy and beyond – perhaps start off in the historic town of Rouen with its cathedral, bustling markets, excellent restaurants and vibrant culture. Visit the impressionist collection in Rouen's Musée des Beaux-Art or drive to the landscapes that have inspired Monet such as the banks of the Seine in nearby La Bouille and the artist's famous gardens in Giverny, just over an hour away.

The Belle Époque seaside resort of Deauville is a wonderful day out with its designer boutiques, casino and fantastic beach, as is the picture-perfect fishing village of



Honfleur. You could even spend time in the great city of Paris or stay closer to home to potter around local villages and market towns, sampling regional specialities in traditional restaurants and appreciating the rural landscapes of this welcoming part of Normandy.

## Location & Local Information

Farmhouse Lazuline is in the Eure department of Normandy, 40km south-west of the beautiful town of Rouen. It neighbours the elegant Château Lazuline (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/chateau-lazuline/>) although both properties are private thanks to a hedge of pine trees.

Surrounded by rural countryside and farmland where cows often graze, you will find the nearest restaurants and a boulangerie in the small town of Bourg Achard (5km). There is a Michelin rated restaurant within a short drive whilst private wine tastings can also be arranged.

There is so much to discover across this part of Normandy. Start off in the university town of Rouen (40km), a very charming place with its fascinating history (it's where Joan of Arc was burnt at the stake), wonderful restaurants, shops, markets and a studenty cultural vibe. Admire Rouen's cathedral made so famous by Monet's painting and enjoy the town's quayside by the River Seine.

From Rouen, you could even hop on a train for a great day out in Paris, with trains to Saint-Lazare taking an average of 90 minutes. Alternatively, slightly closer are the gardens of Monet's Giverny (90km) and the small but interesting Musée de Vernon or head to the village of La Bouille (18km) where Monet famously painted landscapes of the Seine.

You are also close to fantastic golf courses and other historic days out such as the D-Day landing beaches around Omaha (151km) and beyond as well as the historic towns of Caen (105km) and Bayeux (130km).

Even closer are Honfleur (52km), a picture-perfect fishing village, and Deauville (65km), known for its Belle Époque ambience, designer boutiques, wonderful beach and famous casino.

Potter around villages and market towns of the region, looking out for a wealth of specialities such as Livarot



Camembert and Pont L'Eveque cheeses, and the much-loved apple brandy called Calvados. The Friday morning market in Pont Audemer (25km) is especially good whilst there are many others scattered across the area, not to mention several traditional restaurants serving fabulous local cuisine of Normandy.

- The farmhouse is next to the owners' Château Lazuline (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/normandy/chateau-lazuline/>) but they are both private from each other, separated by a pine tree hedge and with their own entrances.
- Subject to availability, both Château and Farmhouse Lazuline can be booked together, sleeping a maximum of 20 guests.

- **Security deposit:** €500 charged to the client's credit card as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 5.00 p.m.
