Upstairs, six double bedrooms provide spacious and comfortable accommodations. Some rooms have handmade wooden beds, flowing curtains, and access to terraces with views. Two bedrooms include ensuite bathrooms, while two additional shared bathrooms are available.

Location & Local Information

Nestled snugly into the hillside amidst ancient olive groves, Villa Miles overlooks the Pagasitkos Gulf near the village of Pelion, Thessaloniki, on the mainland of northern Greece, with stunning views of the Mediterranean Sea. Set within a nine-thousand-square-metre plot, the villa offers panoramic sea vistas, with Mount Pelion commanding views of the Gulf of Magnesia and the Euboia Sea, the legendary setting of Jason and the Argonauts. The nearest airport, Nea Anchialos National Airport in Volos, lies a one-hour drive, thirty-four kilometres away.


Surrounded by mountains, the villa offers secluded tranquillity ideal for hiking along stone paths, through forests and green slopes to picturesque beaches. Noteworthy among them are Mylopotamus, Agios Ioannis, Herefto, and Fakistra, boasting crystal-clear cobalt blue waters and various amenities.

Pelion, shunning mass tourism, invites exploration by car, particularly to its charming villages like Makrinitsa, Portaria, Milies, and Tsagarada, adorned with traditional three-story architecture and lush greenery. Activities abound, from mountain biking and snorkelling to wine tasting and exploring Greek Orthodox churches. A visit to Volos, a bustling coastal city known for its fish restaurants and Tsipouro, is essential, offering a blend of history, culture, and scenic beauty.

Pelion's allure extends throughout the year, with its postcard-perfect villages, snowy landscapes, and nearby ski centre in Chania promising both summer and winter delights. This is the Greece where you drive through a village square with men sat around sipping dark coffee or a glass of milky ouzo, counting beads on a string.

- The bedrooms configuration is five double beds, some with extra single beds for younger family members, and one room with two twin beds. Only two of the double bedrooms are ensuite, the other two bathrooms are shared
