Location & Local Information

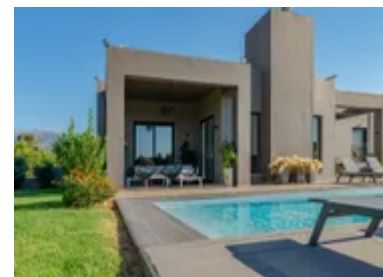
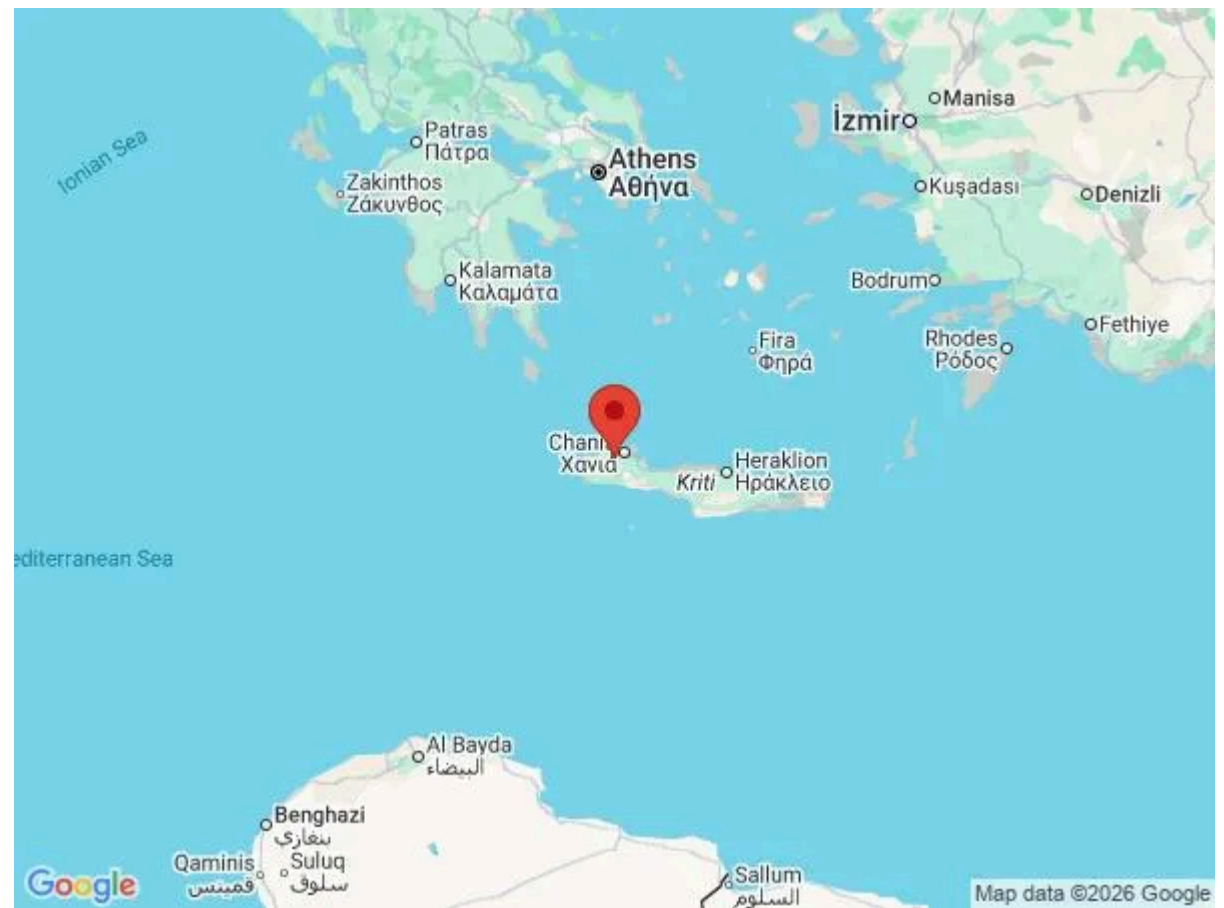
Villa Gypsum is situated in the tranquil village of Alikianos, located 12km from the Old Town of Chania and 9km from the nearest beach. It offers a quaint setting featuring an ancient bridge over the River Keritis, a mix of modern and traditional stone houses, several war monuments, a village shop, and a bakery. The Tower Da Molin, once owned by a Venetian ruler in the Middle Ages, is a notable landmark in the area, with local lore suggesting it may be haunted.

A short drive away lies Kalamaki, a welcoming resort just outside Chania. With its beautiful sandy beach, clear waters, diverse dining options, and convenient shops, it provides an enjoyable retreat. Beachside restaurants often offer complimentary treats like raki and fruit or dessert. Dining experiences range from traditional Greek fare to upscale options such as Corinna Star at Corinna Mare and the restaurant at the Domes Noruz Chania Hotel.

Chania Old Town often likened to Venice of the East, is a captivating destination with charming streets lined with unique shops, a vibrant dining scene, and trendy waterfront bars. The Venetian harbour, built in the 14th century, is a bustling hub for tourists and locals alike, offering picturesque views, especially during sunset. Notable landmarks include the Egyptian lighthouse and the Giali Tzamisi, the oldest Muslim building in Crete, which hosts various cultural events.

- **Security deposit:** There is no security deposit, but should there be any damage or loss caused by you or your guests during your stay you will be liable for the cost

- **Linen & towels included?:** Housekeeping every 2/3 days. For reservations of 5 to 7 days, we provide one change of linens and towels, and for stays longer than 7 days, we offer one change of linens and towels every 4 days.

- **Changeover day:** Flexible
- **End of stay cleaning:** Standard changeover clean included in the price. Guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. - **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
