

Villa Adalet

Overview

Make memories at Villa Adalet, nestled in the hills of Hisaronu near the popular resort of Olu Deniz on Turkey's Turquoise Coast. This stunning three-storey villa offers six bedrooms and eight bathrooms, comfortably accommodating up to twelve guests — perfect for a large family or group of friends.

Set within private grounds with magnificent views of Babadag Mountain, the villa is enclosed by a stone wall and features a paved terrace, lawn and impressive private swimming pool. Guests enjoy private parking, complimentary air conditioning and Wi-Fi throughout, plus smart TVs in every room. Designed in classic Mediterranean style with whitewashed stone walls, marble floors and floor-to-ceiling windows, the villa is bright and airy throughout. The interiors are cool and contemporary, with neutral tones and sleek finishes.

On the ground floor, a spacious open-plan living area includes a large L-shaped sofa, additional seating and a smart TV. The dining area seats eight, while the fully equipped modern kitchen features high-end appliances, including an American-style fridge freezer. A guest cloakroom and a ground-floor double bedroom with en-suite shower and direct access to the pool terrace complete this level — ideal for guests with limited mobility.

Upstairs, three en-suite bedrooms occupy the first floor (two doubles and one twin), each with balconies and TVs. The top floor offers two further en-suite bedrooms (one double, one twin) with panoramic balconies, along with a Finnish-style sauna, mountain-view Jacuzzi bath and separate shower room. A utility room with washing facilities completes the interior.



Outside, the enclosed garden centres around a Roman-step swimming pool, surrounded by sun loungers and parasols. There's a poolside shower, covered seating area, alfresco dining table for eight and a built-in barbecue — perfect for relaxed days and sunset evenings.

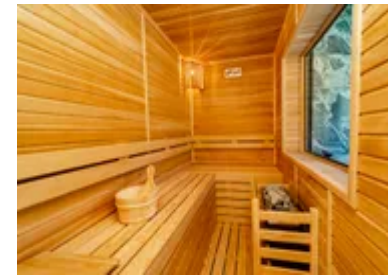

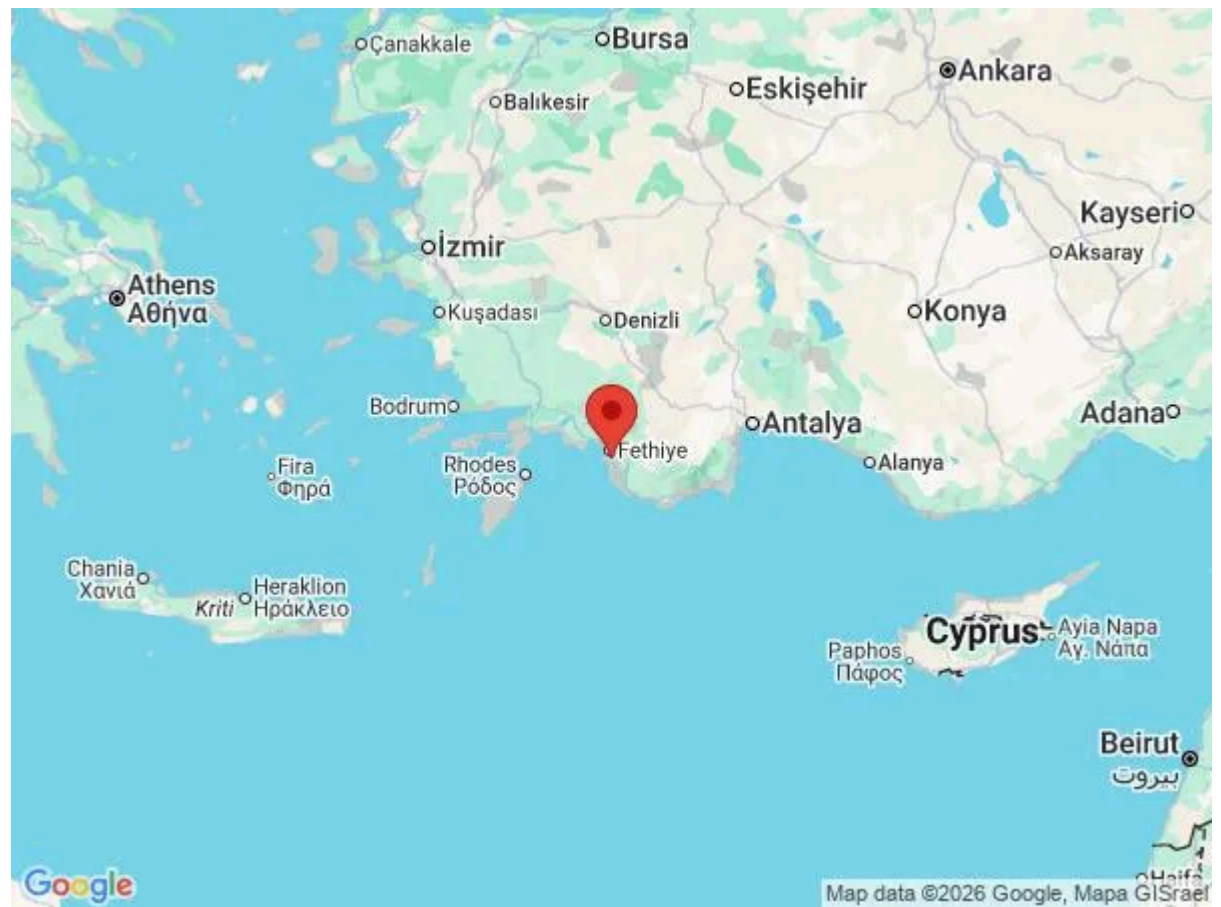
Location & Local Information

Villa Adalet is located in the holiday hot spot of Hisaronu, fifty kilometres or a forty-five minute drive from Dalaman international airport. It is cleverly situated between the bustling town of Fethiye, and the desirable destination of Olu Deniz, both just fifteen minutes away. For holiday provisions local shops and restaurants are just a three hundred metre walk away. Hisaronu is home to a host of supermarkets, cafes, bars, and restaurants, a busy nightlife, and some super souvenir shops too.

Take a short drive down to Oludeniz, where you will find one of the world's best golden sandy beaches, the iconic and much photographed blue lagoon and spit, and adrenalin-inducing water sports. In the evening the town comes alive with lively seashore restaurants and bars, and a chance to indulge in some exclusive shopping. From Olu Deniz you can hop aboard a water taxi to Butterfly Valley, or alternatively cross the sea to Gemile Island aka Aya Nikola, a natural protected area, that is now an open-air museum. For the thrill seekers, head up the hill and take the cable car to the top of Mount Babadag, at almost two thousand metres you can jump off and paraglide solo or in tandem and land on Olu Deniz beach. For shopping and the city Fethiye is your go-to destination.

Fethiye is a harbour town with yachts moored the length of the coastline, home to an ancient amphitheatre, historical museum and rock tombs, and an embarkation point for the obligatory Twelve Island boat trip. There is a foodie-heaven fish market for a catch of the day fabulous feast, super souvenir shops selling your favourite designer brands, and famed for its large local Tuesday market selling everything from home grown organic produce to hand crafted art and artefacts. A walk around the newly paved panoramic coastline will take you to the town and beach of Calis, home to more restaurants and bars, and a local market.

If it's history you are after, you've come to the right place, hike the Lycian Way and take a trip through time. Trace the past with trips to Xanthos, the ancient capital of Lycia, and



home to the oldest republic in the world, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, discover mosaics, amphitheatres, agoras, and an acropolis. Walk the ancient ruins of Patara, the birthplace of St Nicholas, better known as Santa Claus, and lose yourself its twenty kilometres of sandy beach, home to the famous Turkish breeding turtles. Explore the rock tombs of Tlos, carved in the façade of the ancient city ruins, where you will find a necropolis, Roman baths, and an Ottoman Basilica. Head for Letoon to see the mosaic of the goddess Leto, as you wander through the Temple of Apollo. Whilst the honeycomb cliffs of Pinara hosts nine hundred rock tombs and a theatre in verdant setting. In Fethiye you will find ancient sites dating back to two hundred years BC, the Lycian city of Telmessos, and the rock tombs of Amyntas, as well as sarcophagi, and a theatre immediately opposite the harbour, built to hold six thousand spectators, climb to the top for some fabulous sea views. Bring all of this together in the Fethiye Museum, full of local history, culture, and ephemera, most notably the Trilingual Stele, excavated at Letoon and inscribed with the languages of Lycia, Ancient Greek and Aramaic.

- Villa Adalet is just so stylish, from the super sharp exterior to the cool contemporary interior, a holiday here takes vacation villas to the next level

What you should know...

- The villa is in a strategic position, but the nearest beach is a ten minute drive away. It is a very steep downhill walk, but there is a good local public transport system to take you down and back
- We recommend hiring a car to make the most out of your holiday and see all the fabulous sights there is to see
- Villa Adalet is ideal for those with mobility issues, as the grounds and gardens are flat, and there is a spacious ground floor bedroom with an ensuite bathroom, and doors that open directly onto the terrace

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10-year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
