

Villa Abacus

Overview

Set on the south coast of Paros with captivating views across the Aegean Sea towards Antiparos, Villa Abacus is a stylish three-bedroom retreat ideal for families or groups of up to six. This one hundred and five square metre, two-storey villa blends traditional Cycladic architecture with contemporary comforts, offering a light-filled interior finished in soothing tones of white and blue, complemented by natural wood accents.

Located within a boutique complex of six detached villas in the Petaloudes valley of Glisadia, the property sits on a two-acre olive grove estate. Thoughtfully positioned to shelter from the northern winds, each villa enjoys privacy, independent access, private parking for two vehicles, and access to a generous shared pool terrace with a fourteen metre by eight metre sea-view swimming pool, sun loungers, parasols, a bar lounge, and changing facilities.

Villa Abacus features an open-plan ground floor with a fully equipped kitchen, dining for six, and a comfortable living area opening onto a sea-view terrace. Upstairs, three serene double bedrooms include a master with an ensuite and smart TV, while two further bedrooms share a bathroom and private balconies. Additional highlights include two furnished terraces, laundry facilities, and concierge services offering yacht charters, in-villa dining, wellness sessions, and event planning. A sandy, family-friendly beach is just a short drive away.

Location & Local Information

Villa Abacus sits within an exclusive six-villa enclave on the serene south coast of Paros, one of the Cycladic islands in the heart of the Aegean Sea. Perched on the slope of an ancient olive grove, the villa enjoys sweeping panoramic views of the sea. It lies close to the beautifully named Petaloudes valley, meaning 'Valley of the Butterflies', in the tranquil Glisadia area. The property is conveniently located just four kilometres from both the international airport of Paros and the port of Pounta, ideal for guests island hopping.



Several sandy beaches with calm, shallow waters are nearby, including the secluded Paralia Agia Irini and Kite Beach. Further afield, Kolymbithres is renowned for its dramatic rock formations, golden sands, and crystal-clear waters. On windier days, Faraggas and Monastiri offer natural shelter, while Santa Maria and Golden Beach provide lively, cosmopolitan settings.

A visit to Parikia, the island's historic capital, is a must. Discover the fourth-century Byzantine church of Panagia Ekatontapiliani, explore the Venetian Frankish Castle, and enjoy sweeping views from its hilltop perch. Wander cobbled lanes lined with blue-and-white houses, vibrant bougainvillea, artisan shops, and ouzo bars. Parikia also boasts several beaches, including the quiet coves of Delfini and the lively stretch of Lividia.

To the north, Naousa offers rustic charm, a scenic harbour, and lively nightlife. Paros also caters to active travellers with hiking trails, cycling routes, kitesurfing, windsurfing, and watersports. For a change of pace, take a day trip to Antiparos and unwind on its unspoilt beaches such as Faneromeni, Agios Georgios, and Sifneikos Gialos.
