Overview

Enjoy a vacation of opulent elegance when you stay at the waterside Casa Isabella, in the San Marco district of central Venice, on the northeast Italian coast. This stunning south-facing property is arranged over two floors, and benefits from iconic Venetian vistas, looking across the azure Grand Canal lagoon to the Guggenheim Museum and glistening cupolas.

This luxurious residence has four spacious en-suite double bedrooms, and can comfortably accommodate up to eight guests, ideal for a large family or group of friends' sharing. The palazzo comes complete with complimentary air conditioning, and central heating, and unlimited Wi-Fi throughout.

Casa Isabella has been recently restored to its former glory, retaining the original stucco ceilings and period floors, and cleverly combining them with contemporary fixtures, fittings, and furniture, and Venice inspired art work, to create an impressive, yet welcoming holiday home from home. The property is topped and tailed by the most unexpected private walled garden, and a roof terrace with panoramic views over the city of Venice.

Enter the residence to discover the most stylish, light and airy, living space. Take the marble staircase to the first floor, where there is a salon-style sitting room with two large comfy sofas, animal print armchairs, and handy glass coffee tables. The second seating area has a smart television with Netflix, and plush sofas. The ornate dining room, with crystal chandelier, has a table and chairs to seat eight, the perfect place for some seriously impressive entertaining. A fully fitted modern kitchen is equipped with all the latest appliances to cater for your stay. On this floor there are two beautifully appointed double bedrooms, both with king size beds, canal views, and en-suite exquisite marble bathrooms with huge bathtubs. The second floor is home to two further double bedrooms, both with south aspect water views, and en-suite bathrooms. One of the bedrooms has a king size bed and bathtub, and the other has a convertible set of twin beds and a shower room. The outside space is like having two extra living rooms.

Enjoy sunbathing on the sun loungers, and cocktails at the soft seating area, as the sun sets over the city. Relax in the waterside private enclosed garden with its lush green lawn, enjoy a coffee and a catch up at the soft seating area under a shady pergola. Dine alfresco at the classic wrought iron ten seater table under a Venetian blue sky, as the gondolas drift gently by.

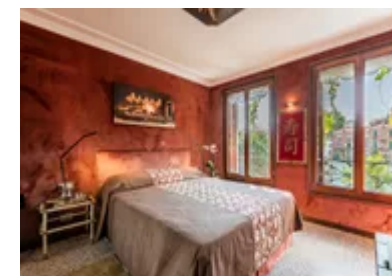
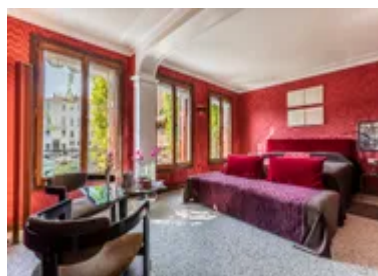
Location & Local Information

Casa Isabella is perfectly positioned near the Grand Canal, in the San Marco district of central Venice, across from the Guggenheim Museum, with views of the iconic azure blue lagoon.

The international Marco Polo airport is a forty minute private water taxi journey away, or seventy five minutes by the public vaporetto. The apartment is ideally located within walking distance of most of the major sights of Venice, and one of the joys of a holiday here, is walking over many of the four hundred bridges, and some of one hundred and eighteen canals, as the architecture reveals the city's colourful history. It's a ten minute walk to the impressive St Mark's Square, and the eleventh century Basilica, where mass is still held today. Visit the Byzantine Doge's Palace, climb the clocktower, and cross the Bridge of Sighs. On the other side of St Mark's Square is the Correr Museum, highlighting the history of Venice in its royal rooms and library. Take time out to stroll around the square, window shop in the jewellery stores, before sitting down for tea in Florian's, whilst the orchestra plays your favourite tunes.

Cross the bridge or take a gondola taxi to the Napoleonic Accademia Gallery to view classical Venetian Renaissance art, and the nearby seventeenth century Basilica of Santa Maria della Salute, with its iconic cupola and twelve paintings by Titian. Make time to visit the Peggy Guggenheim Museum, an homage to twentieth century modern art, housed in her original palazzo home. Take a three island tour to see the glassblowers at work on Murano, the colourful houses and lacemakers of Burano, and the seventh century cathedral on Torcello, with its Byzantine art. Cross the Adriatic Sea to the Lido, famous for its grand hotels, long sandy beaches, and for those who like to chance their luck, there's a casino too. Venice is a food lovers paradise, sample the local dish of Baccala Mantecato, a salted cod dish, best served with a chilled white wine.

A walk to St Mark's Square will take you through back



streets full of shops selling the very best quality hand crafted leather goods, silk scarves, and cashmere sweaters. The fashionistas will love that many of Italy's most famous designers have their brand label stores on one street leading into the square.

For the romantics, get into a gondola and cruise the canals, or simply take one, to cross the water from one side to the other. In the evening enjoy a stroll to Harry's Bar for a Bellini, before a night at the opera at the famous Fenice Theatre, then dine in a local restaurant, serving traditional Venetian dishes overlooking the Grand Canal, under a Tiepolo blue sky. If you are lucky enough to be there during Carnival time, make sure you wear a mysterious mask, and join in the fun and frolics of this fabulous festival.
