Overview

Villa Serpil offers a tranquil and secure getaway for those seeking privacy and comfort. Located in the hills above Kalkan, a renowned destination on Turkey's Turquoise Coast, the villa is part of a small, exclusive complex of luxury villas designed to resemble a traditional Turkish village. This two-storey, detached villa is surrounded by a stone wall, featuring a private garden and swimming pool, providing an intimate setting for relaxation.

The complex is equipped with 24/7 security and an alarm system, ensuring peace of mind. The villa offers air conditioning throughout and unlimited Wi-Fi for your convenience. Guests will also have access to a designated three-car parking area, as well as the complex's long swimming pool, children's pool, and sun loungers with parasols. A family-friendly clubhouse serves meals from breakfast to dinner, while a stylish cocktail bar and lounge provide a space for relaxation and socializing. Villa Serpil's three bedrooms comfortably accommodate up to six guests, making it perfect for families or small groups of friends.

The villa's exterior features classic whitewashed walls, wooden shutters, and a Juliet balcony with views of the Mediterranean Sea. Inside, the warm and inviting decor combines modern furnishings with traditional Turkish lighting and artwork, set against a palette of earthy tones and vibrant orange accents.

Approaching the villa via a tree-lined road, guests will arrive at the villa, set on a stone path surrounded by lush local shrubs, terracotta planters, and colourful bougainvillea. The ground floor offers an open-plan living area, flooded with natural light, and French doors that open to the garden and pool. The seating area includes two large sofas, a pouffe, and an HD smart television. The



adjacent dining area features an elegant wooden table with six upholstered chairs, perfect for indoor dining. The fully equipped kitchen includes modern appliances, such as a fridge, freezer, oven, hob, dishwasher, microwave, and juicer for a fresh start to your day. A guest cloakroom completes the ground floor.

Upstairs, three spacious double bedrooms await. The master bedroom includes a double bed, wardrobe, side tables, an en-suite bathroom with a walk-in shower, and a sea view balcony. The second bedroom features a double bed, while the third offers two twin beds. A shared bathroom with a walk-in shower, vanity unit, and WC serves these two bedrooms.

The private garden is a highlight, with a step-entry swimming pool surrounded by sun loungers with orange cushions and matching parasols, as well as an outdoor shower. For dining al fresco, a pergola covers a stylish rattan dining set with six cushioned chairs, where you can enjoy a meal and raise a toast to a memorable holiday.



Location & Local Information

Villa Serpil can be found nestled in the hills two kilometres above the quaint harbour town of Kalkan, situated on Turkey's Turquoise Coast, the jewel of the Mediterranean Sea. Kalkan was originally a Greek enclave called Kalamaki, and Ottoman and Hellenic influences can be found in the winding streets of the old harbour town. Walk through the cobbled streets full of traditional white houses, home to a reputed one hundred and fifty restaurants, cafes, bars, enticing souvenir shops, and designer brand stores stuffed with objects of desire. After dark, dine in one of the famous rooftop restaurants with stunning harbour and sea views, sampling traditional Turkish delights and international cuisine.

Villa Serpil is located on a small complex of luxury properties designed by an award-winning Turkish architect. Staying at the villa includes complimentary use of their semi Olympic sized swimming pool, restaurant, cocktail bar, and lounge, perfect for meeting up with other holidaymakers and swapping stories and tips.

From the villa it is a short drive into Kalkan, where you can find supermarkets and banks, and a local Thursday market, that can cater for all the provisions you will need for a happy holiday. Take a trip into town, and at the harbour get aboard one of the complimentary water taxis to one of the many exclusive beach clubs. The beach clubs all have bathing platforms, sea views, sun lounger waiter service, restaurants, and bars, and some offer full size swimming pools, water sports, and spa services too. For the beach bunnies, Kalkan has its own pebble beach with organised sun loungers and brollies, easy access into the calm Mediterranean sea, and its own cute cafe. Travel further afield to the stunning Kaputas Beach set in a natural gorge, only two hundred steps down and two hundred steps back up, but well worth it for the scenery and the sea. Take a trip to Patara, where you will find twenty kilometres of unspoilt golden sands, and a protected area for the hatching Caretta Caretta turtles. Patara also boasts an archaeological site over two thousand years old, with not just one but two ancient



amphitheatres, not to mention the most stunning sunsets, best seen from the ever-changing sand dunes.

No stay in Kalkan is complete without a boat trip from the harbour, whether it's a shared one with family and friends, or you charter your own gulet, a day out at sea with your favourite captain and crew, is one that memories are made of. All aboard for a day of swimming and snorkelling in beautiful bays, enjoy a meal of local homecooked meze, take afternoon tea, and then sail back to harbour cocktail in hand to watch the sunset.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10-year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the *Turkish Consulate* for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
