Overview

Set amidst the Cretan countryside with far-reaching views across the Aegean Sea, Villa Monasteria is a stylish retreat on the island's north coast, designed for relaxed group getaways. Spanning four levels and offering seven well-appointed bedrooms, the villa comfortably sleeps up to sixteen guests, ideal for extended families or friends travelling together.

This three hundred and ninety square metre property is enclosed within private gardens and high stone walls, with tall trees offering shade and seclusion. A large swimming pool with a separate shallow area for children anchors the outdoor space, which also includes sun loungers, shaded seating, a pergola-covered daybed, and a dedicated play area. Guests can make the most of al fresco dining with an outdoor kitchen and built-in barbecue, perfect for evening meals against a sunset backdrop.

Inside, the villa features contemporary interiors with colourful accents and standout themed bathrooms. The main living area includes a generous lounge with a sixty-five-inch TV, a wood-burning stove, and a full-sized pool table, alongside a sleek kitchen and dining space.

Additional highlights include a second living area with extra sleeping space, a games room with gym equipment and a daily buffet breakfast service (excluding Sundays). With garage parking, an internal lift, air conditioning, Wi-Fi, and thoughtful touches for children, Villa Monasteria promises a superb stay for guests of all ages.

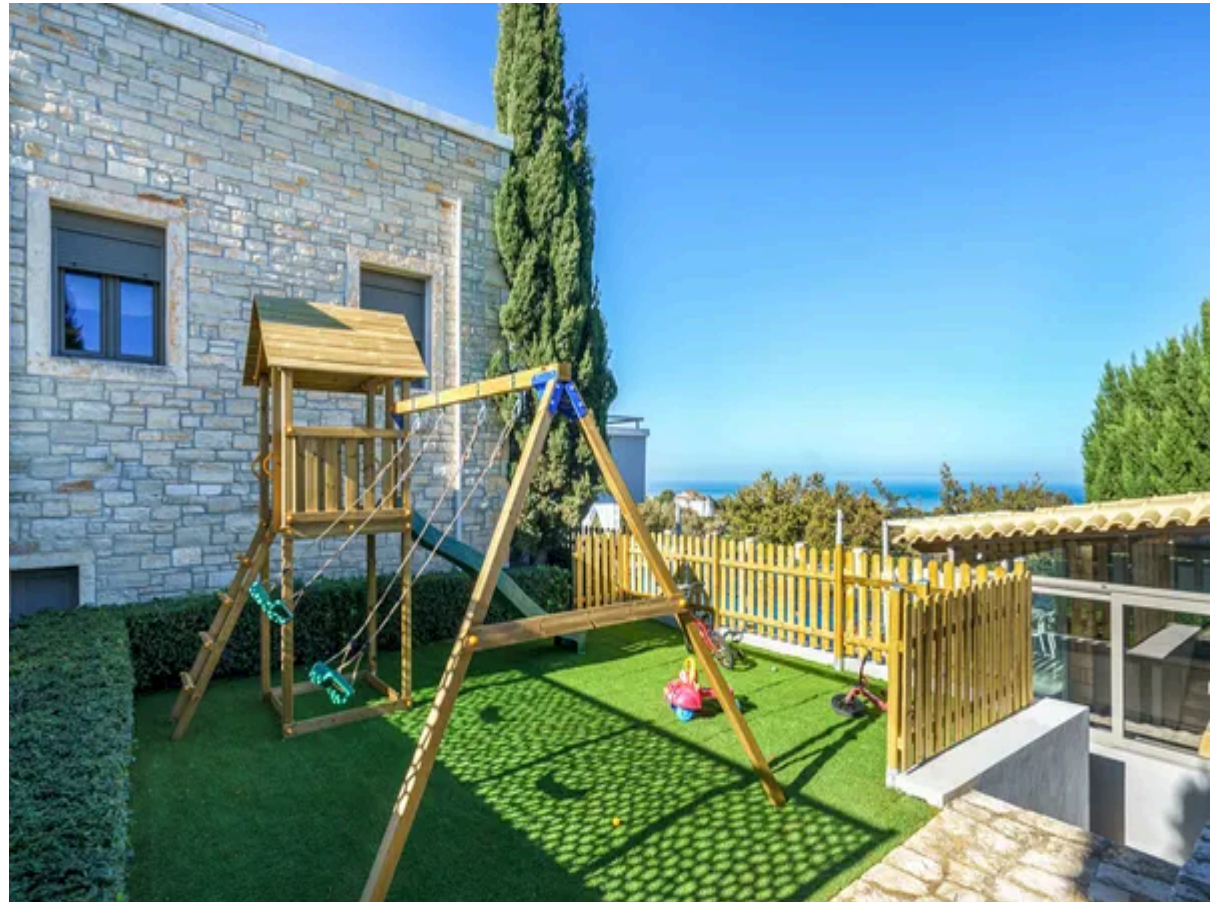

Location & Local Information

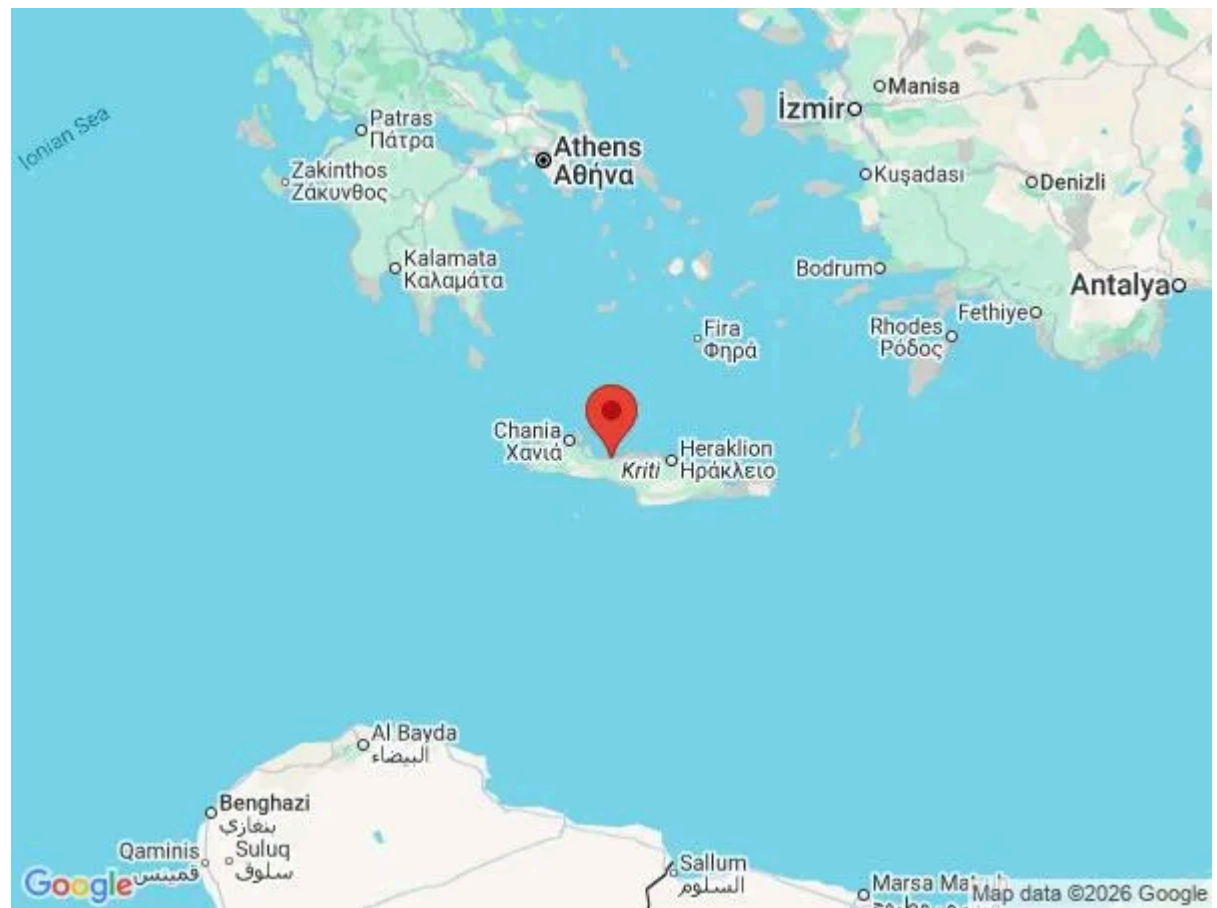
Villa Monasteria is set in the tranquil countryside near the traditional village of Tria Monasteria, close to the town of Rethymno on the north coast of Crete, overlooking the Aegean Sea. The villa is approximately seventy kilometres from Chania International Airport. Whether you seek peaceful days on sandy beaches, cultural visits to ancient archaeological sites, scenic hikes through diverse landscapes, or lively nights out, Crete offers something for everyone.

Nearby Tria Monasteria offers local shops and welcoming, family-run tavernas serving authentic Greek cuisine. The region boasts beautiful beaches such as Missiria, Pervolia, Adelianos Kampos, and Preveli, known for its striking pine forest. Just six kilometres away, Rethymno's historic old town features a Venetian harbour, cobbled streets, a sixteenth-century fortress, and a nineteenth-century lighthouse. Cultural highlights include the Archaeological Museum and the Historical and Folklore Museum. Enjoy freshly caught seafood and ouzo by the sea or explore the island's network of caves, scenic walking trails, and working vineyards. Crete's coastline offers boat trips, snorkelling, scuba diving, jet skiing, and paragliding. A one-hour drive east leads to Heraklion and the famed Palace of Knossos, with its Minoan heritage and excellent museums.

Further afield, discover the palm groves of Vai, the mythical Psychro Cave, and the Ideon Cave on Mount Ida. The Sitia Geopark spans three hundred and fifty square kilometres of diverse ecosystems, while Richtis Gorge rewards hikers with a twenty-metre waterfall and natural pools. Don't miss a boat trip to Spinalonga, a former leper colony turned open-air museum. End your exploration in Agios Nikolaos, where a picturesque lake sits at the town's heart, surrounded by charming streets, local shops, and waterside tavernas.

- **Other 2:** The pool is not covered, but built to the standards of the Greek Tourism Organisation EOT. Parents have full responsibility for supervision of their minor children No children under the age of 12 permitted the pool at any time without adult supervision. When using the pool, remember there is a certain health risk associated with this facility.
- **Other 3:** Please be aware that the minimum age to book this property is 25 years old.
- **Minimum stay:** Please note that there is a 5-night minimum stay, this may be increased across peak dates
- **Pool heating charge?:** For those who require pool heating, there will be an additional charge of €560 (to be paid locally on arrival). Please note that like all heated pools, pool heating and water temperature are reliant on weather and outside temperatures.
- **Internet access?:** The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
