Overview

Set just moments from the beach on Naxos's serene west coast, Villas Kastraki offers the perfect setting for a relaxed Greek island escape. This distinctive property comprises two mirror-image villas, each with its own entrance, living space and two bedrooms, making it ideal for extended families or groups of up to twelve guests. A central terrace with a sea-view swimming pool creates a natural gathering spot, framed by breathtaking views of the Aegean.

Designed in classic Cycladic style, the villas feature whitewashed façades, stone walls and breezy, coastal interiors. Cool tiled floors, contemporary furnishings and a palette of crisp white with marine blue accents give each space a refined Mediterranean charm. On the ground floor, open-plan living areas flow onto the pool terrace, while well-equipped kitchens include everything from a fridge freezer to a morning coffee maker. Each villa also offers a quest WC.

Upstairs, each home has a master double bedroom opening onto a balcony with panoramic sea views and a Jacuzzi bath, alongside a twin room with mountain views. A shared marble bathroom with a walk-in shower completes the layout.

Step outside to sun loungers, shaded seating, and a stone path leading to a peaceful sandy beach. Evenings invite al fresco dining and sunset drinks under the stars, everything you need for a memorable stay by the sea.

Location & Local Information

Villas Kastraki enjoy a prime position overlooking Kastraki Beach on the west coast of Naxos, the largest of the Cyclades islands in the heart of the Aegean Sea. The island is accessible via a forty-five-minute flight from Athens, followed by a twenty-minute drive to the villa. Alternatively, visitors can take a ferry from Athens' ports or island hop from Santorini, Paros, Milos, los, or Mykonos. Supermarkets, cafés, bars, and tavernas are all within walking distance, while a sandy, secluded beach lies just steps away. Follow the path from the villa to discover golden dunes, cedar trees, and the crystal-clear waters of the Aegean.

Naxos is a renowned destination for water sports, particularly kitesurfing and windsurfing, thanks to the reliable Meltemi winds and seven major clubs scattered along the coast. The villa is close to unspoilt Glyfada Beach and its kitesurfing centre. Other notable beaches include Agia Anna, known for its sea caves and waterfront tavernas; Aliko, with its cedar forest backdrop; Mikri Vigla, popular for water sports; Agios Prokopios, lined with restaurants; and Plaka, with four kilometres of organised loungers and parasols.

Head sixteen kilometres north to Naxos Town (Chora) to explore Venetian architecture, the thirteenth-century castle, archaeological museums, and the iconic Portara, the marble gateway of an unfinished temple, best viewed at sunset. Inland, traditional villages such as Koronas and Chalki offer a glimpse of local life. Visit the Vallindra Distillery to sample Kitron, the island's signature citrus liqueur.

For outdoor enthusiasts, Naxos offers hiking, cycling, mountain biking, horseback riding, snorkelling, and scuba diving. Cliff diving caters to thrill-seekers, while history buffs can explore ancient sites, including the Temple of Demeter, the Kouros statues, and Byzantine museums. The island is also home to many peaceful monasteries and churches adorned with frescoes and icons.

Complete your stay with a boat trip to hidden coves, a vineyard wine tasting, or an evening at the open-air cinema, followed by a leisurely dinner in a local taverna.
