# Location & Local Information

This picturesque destination has it all - from world-renowned wineries to historic landmarks and breathtaking scenery, making it an ideal destination for travellers who want to experience the authentic Tuscan lifestyle.

If you're a wine lover, you should take advantage of the opportunity to visit some of the area's top wineries. Sip on some of the region's finest wines while learning about winemaking at famous wineries such as *Castello di Radda*, *Tenuta di Capraia*, and *Castello di Albola*.

For those interested in history, Radda in Chianti has a rich past reflected in its medieval architecture and landmarks. Stroll along the village's ancient walls, visit the Palazzo del Podestà, or stop by the Romanesque church of Santa Maria Novella to discover the town's unique heritage.

Nature enthusiasts will love exploring the rolling hills, vineyards, and olive groves of Tuscany on foot or by bike along the many hiking and biking trails in the area.

If you fancy getting stuck into delicious Tuscan cuisine, why not book a cooking class at the villa to learn how to make traditional Tuscan dishes using fresh, local ingredients and indulge in the region's delicious specialities such as Florentine steak, pasta with truffles, and of course, gelato.

If you're lucky enough to visit during the right time of year, be sure to check out the many festivals and events in the area, including the Chianti Classico Wine Festival, the Radda nel Bicchiere Wine Tasting Event, and the Radda Antiques Market.

Castellina in Chianti (12km) is a picturesque town known for its stunning medieval architecture, including the impressive Rocca, a fortress that dates back to the 14th century. Visitors to Castellina in Chianti can explore the charming old town, filled with narrow streets, quaint shops, and traditional Tuscan restaurants. The town is also home to several wineries and olive groves, where visitors can taste the local wines and olive oils.

This charming Tuscan city of Siena (32km) is famous for its great Gothic architecture, winding medieval streets, and rich history. Visitors can explore the Piazza del Campo, the city's heart and home to the famous Palio horse race, and the magnificent Siena Cathedral with its intricate façade and beautiful frescoes. Several museums and art galleries, including the Pinacoteca Nazionale di Siena, also house a collection of Renaissance masterpieces.
