

Location & Local Information

Grandola Views is located just 10 minutes away from the centre of Grandola, meaning that guests can explore every element of this outstanding area without straying too far away from this impeccable villa. One of the region's most alluring monuments is Praca do Giraldo, a vast medieval manor house that holds an abundance of gruesome history. These far-reaching grounds have witnessed an abundance of battles, such as a collection of daunting executions that occurred throughout the troubling times of the Spanish Inquisition. This landmark is also regarded as a UNESCO World Heritage site, further highlighting its incredible significance throughout Europe. Despite its frightening legacy, this building is surrounded by artisan cafes and shops, allowing guests to truly soak up the charming atmosphere of this local area. Praca do Giraldo has situated just over an hour away from the villa.

The Cathedral of Evora is a truly inspiring landmark that expresses a wide variety of innate Gothic motifs. As the largest medieval castle in the entirety of Europe, it boasts two looming towers as well as a titanic collection of cloisters. Inside, this moment showcases an authentic polychrome statue of the Virgin Mary, giving guests a chance to deepen their knowledge of Grandola's rich religious history. This landmark is also on the UNESCO World Heritage Tentative List, showcasing its prosperous future as an iconic attraction. The Cathedral of Evora can be found around an hour and 20 minutes away from Grandola Views.

Comporta beach is based just over half an hour away from the villa, allowing guests the prime opportunity to detach from the hustle and bustle of everyday life and learn to appreciate the picturesque nature of this attraction. Complete with an abundance of soft golden sand and crystal-clear water; this is a perfect place to visit if you wish to absorb the true beauty of this inspiring and inviting area.
