

Location & Local Information

Villa Cellini lies in the heart of Tuscany and the beautiful Chianti countryside. Whether you're captivated by art and culture or seeking picturesque nature reserves, this region promises a truly unforgettable travel experience.

No trip to Tuscany is complete without exploring the mesmerising city of Florence (61km), approximately a 45-minute drive away. Immerse yourself in the Renaissance-era charm as you walk through the cobbled streets lined with stunning architecture. Marvel at world-famous landmarks such as the Florence Cathedral, Ponte Vecchio, and the Uffizi Gallery, home to an extraordinary art collection, including works by Michelangelo and Botticelli.

An hour's drive from the villa lies the medieval city of Siena, renowned for its preserved Gothic architecture and the historic Palio horse race held in the Piazza del Campo. Lose yourself in the labyrinthine streets of the city centre, visit the magnificent Siena Cathedral, and take in panoramic views from the Torre del Mangia. Remember to sample the local delicacies and indulge in a glass of Chianti wine.

Travel back in time to the Middle Ages with a visit to the captivating hilltop town of San Gimignano. Famous for its well-preserved medieval towers, the town offers a unique atmosphere. Explore the narrow streets lined with charming shops, taste local wines at the vineyards, and climb the Torre Grossa for panoramic views of the Tuscan countryside. Also nearby is the charming town of Arezzo (22km), which sits on top of a hill, overlooking four valleys, and has a history dating back to the Stone Age.

Wine enthusiasts will be delighted by the proximity of the Chianti wine region. Embark on a scenic drive through rolling vineyards and picturesque villages. Stop by renowned wineries to taste exceptional wines, including the world-famous Chianti Classico. Experience the art of winemaking firsthand and savour delicious regional cuisine in rustic trattorias along the way.

For those seeking serene landscapes and postcard-worthy views, visiting the Val d'Orcia (75km) is a must. Approximately 90 minutes away, this UNESCO World Heritage site is characterised by gentle hills, cypress-lined avenues, and charming villages such as Pienza and Montalcino. Take leisurely walks through the countryside, visit ancient monasteries, and capture the region's beauty with your camera. If you like nature reserves, from the house, it is possible to reach Valle dell'Inferno by bike. Here, you can spot animals and birds of the region.
