
Overview

The charming market town of Ledbury is a gateway to the Malvern Hills, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty renowned for its breathtaking landscapes. Surrounded by woods, orchards, and rolling countryside, it's the perfect base for exploring scenic footpaths. Stroll Ledbury's picturesque streets lined with independent shops offering unique artwork, and books, and pause for coffee in its welcoming cafés.

At the heart of Big Apple Country, Ledbury celebrates its orchard heritage with biannual Big Apple Festivals. Yearround, visitors can enjoy Weston's Cider tours and orchard walks or discover Coddington Vineyard, a haven for wine lovers in this flourishing wine region.

Nearby Eastnor Castle offers a fascinating step back in time with its historic state rooms, arboretum, and tranquil lake. Its surrounding Eastnor Deer Park, part of the Malvern Hills AONB, is home to red deer and crisscrossed by trails, including routes to the Eastnor Obelisk and Worcestershire Way.

Ledbury's literary legacy shines during its annual Poetry Festival, the largest in the UK. The Barrett Browning Institute provides further insight into the area's links to iconic writers like Tolkien and C.S. Lewis.

A visit to nearby Hereford completes the experience, with Hereford Cathedral, its SAS memorial, and the historic Black and White Museum revealing the area's rich past.
