- Changeover day: Flexible.
- End of stay cleaning available?: Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit. Effortless departure can be arranged at an additional cost. Please enquire at time of booking.
- Smoking Allowed?: No smoking indoors. The summer house and dovecote in courtyard are the designated sheltered smoking areas and ash trays are provided outside.

After 12am noise from the property in general is to be kept to a reasonable level, with PA system in function room turned off, unless otherwise agreed. Removal or rearranging of decoration (ornaments/paintings etc.) and or furniture is forbidden.
