Villa Gaiola

Region: Amalfi Coast Sleeps: 12

Overview

Perched dramatically on a cliffside near Ravello, Villa Gaiola is a six-bedroom architectural masterpiece overlooking the Tyrrhenian Sea. Its gravity-defying silhouette has captivated boat passengers cruising between Sorrento and Capri for decades. Accessible only on foot, the villa lies just a ten-minute walk from Ravello's central piazza, hidden behind wrought-iron gates and surrounded by six acres of terraced gardens, olive groves, and cypress trees.

Completed in 1927, the villa was first home to Lucille Beckett, daughter of Lord Grimthorpe, but gained fame under the ownership of Gore Vidal, who purchased it in 1972. From this extraordinary residence, Vidal penned several iconic works, including Burr and Lincoln. He and his partner Howard Austen expanded the villa's terraced gardens and added the marble-lined swimming pool in 1984.

Inside, the villa reflects timeless elegance. Restored in 2016, it features classical Roman floor plans, vaulted ceilings, antique furnishings, and 26-foot frescoed ceilings. The layout includes multiple sitting rooms, a panoramic summer living room, and Vidal's untouched rococo study—his "perfect cube"—still home to his desk, chesterfield sofa, and vintage globe.

The six luxurious suites, once host to luminaries like the Jaggers, Andy Warhol, and Tennessee Williams, each offer king-size beds, bespoke wardrobes, and Vietri ceramic floors. The Serenity suite features a Jacuzzi, while Ecstasy boasts breathtaking views, including from a rose window in its bathroom with chromotherapy shower.

Villa Gaiola blends history, art, and nature in a setting of unparalleled beauty. Just a short walk from Ravello's Duomo Square, guests can enjoy the town's vibrant market, fine dining, and boutique shopping. This legendary villa is not only a luxurious escape—it's a piece of Amalfi Coast history.

Location & Local Information

Just a ten-minute walk from the villa lies Ravello, the elegant clifftop town famously dubbed the Balcony of the Amalfi Coast. Long a haven for artists and writers, Ravello hosts cultural highlights like the Ravello Festival, held at Villa Rufolo each July and August. Here, open-air concerts take place with sweeping views of the Gulf of Salerno. Its piazzas are lined with everything from Michelin-starred restaurants to traditional pizzerias, offering exceptional dining between strolls through its stunning architecture and boutique shopping streets.

The Amalfi Coast is renowned for its charming towns and vibrant shopping. Winding streets are filled with stylish clothing, fine leather goods, ceramic art, and the beloved local liqueur, Limoncello. Whether you favour the classic version or an artisanal twist, it's a must-try—and makes a perfect souvenir (just be sure to tape the corks before packing!).

Food lovers can dive deeper into the region's culinary culture through cooking classes, wine tastings, and weekly street markets. Ravello and Sorrento host theirs on Tuesdays, while Amalfi's Thursday market offers a scenic seafront setting. Friday's market in Maiori is perfect for picking up fresh ingredients before enjoying a seaside stroll.

Local tour operators offer a wide range of excursions. Take a boat trip to Capri, famous for its Blue Grotto and turquoise waters, or drive just an hour to explore the ancient ruins of Pompeii. Many tours include added luxuries such as lunch, wine tastings, and snorkelling—making it easy to craft your perfect Amalfi experience.

What you should know...

- The villa is only accessible by foot, there are 30 steps down from the walking path of the garden to reach the main entrance.
- Due to the seven levels of terraced garden, this villa is not suitable for those with mobility issues.
- The office room of Gore Vidal closed to the public, used only as museum.
- The rooms, all located in the main building, are distributed on different levels and can only be reached by using stairs.
- Villa Gaiola is a historical-cultural property subject to protections and constraints and is not equipped with an elevator system, nor can it be equipped with it.
- The villa's private swimming pool isn't fenced, so children should always be supervised when outdoors.
- Child supervision is mandatory especially in the outdoor areas/garden.
- Kitchen facilities for use of staff only.
