Overview

Chalet Lorraine offers a serene mountain retreat in Méribel Mottaret, perched 300 metres above the town centre. Sleeping up to ten guests across five bedrooms, it is an ideal base for exploring the world-class Three Valleys ski area. Mottaret's bars, restaurants, shops, and ski school meeting points are close at hand, with a complimentary shuttle service linking you directly to the heart of Méribel.

The chalet is within a five-minute walk of the local slopes and lifts, offering exceptional convenience. In the shadow of the majestic peak of Mont Vallon and neighbouring Vanoise National Park, Chalet Lorraine enjoys a privileged natural setting. Beyond skiing and snowboarding, activities such as snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, paragliding, horse-drawn carriage rides, and wellness retreats are all available. In summer, mountain biking, hiking, and via ferrata provide further adventure.

Built in classic Savoyard style, the chalet blends rustic character with modern comforts. Inside, wood-clad interiors create a welcoming atmosphere, enhanced by an indoor hot tub, sauna, and a crackling fireplace. The lower ground floor houses the wellness facilities and three double bedrooms, each with an en-suite shower room, alongside an additional shared shower room.

The ground floor offers a spacious living room with access to a south-facing balcony, a contemporary fireplace, and a television. A dedicated dining room and a well-equipped kitchen ensure comfort for self-catered stays. A practical ski and boot room completes the floor.

Upstairs, two twin bedrooms are complemented by a shared shower room, with one bedroom featuring its own balcony to take in the Alpine views.

Méribel boasts 150km of pistes and, as part of the Three Valleys, access to an impressive 600km of ski runs. Famed for its authentic Alpine charm, it combines traditional architecture with modern amenities including an Olympic sports complex, swimming pool, climbing wall, ice rink, and spa. Family-friendly activities, such as tobogganing, igloo building, and the Moon Park, enhance its year-round appeal. With easy access to exceptional skiing and vibrant après-ski, Chalet Lorraine promises an unforgettable mountain experience.

Location & Local Information

Chalet Lorraine enjoys a scenic position in Mottaret, 300 metres above Méribel's centre, with a convenient bus service nearby. Mottaret offers excellent access to the Three Valleys, with recent enhancements including a new children's area, night skiing, and an upgraded lift system. The Coombes chair provides quicker access to Courchevel than starting in Courchevel itself, and Val Thorens is reachable via just two lifts and a short blue run. Mottaret's altitude of 1,750 metres ensures reliable snow conditions, alongside a range of bars, shops, and restaurants.

A bus from outside the chalet links to La Chaudanne and Méribel's lively centre, home to a cinema, spa, boutique shops, ski hire outlets, and nightlife. The Olympic Centre hosts major events, offering an ice rink, climbing wall, bowling alley, pool, and spa. Ski schools, creche facilities, and the Piou-Piou club are also located here.

Founded by Scotsman Peter Lindsay before World War II, Méribel blends Alpine charm with modern infrastructure. It offers 150km of pistes and easy access to the wider Three Valleys' 600km network. The skiing caters to all levels, from gentle greens to challenging blacks, with snow parks, freestyle zones, and off-piste activities enhancing its appeal. Méribel's vibrant aprèsski and authentic village atmosphere create an unforgettable experience.
