Moreover, there are several wonderful sites and tourist attractions to see here. Walk just 10 minutes to the nearest viewpoint offering an amazing view of the surrounding countryside. Be sure to also stop by the King's Tower and the Monolithic Church of Saint-Émilion in the centre of town, just a 15-minute walk away.

In addition, the beautiful city of Bordeaux can be reached by car in under an hour. Head for a day out exploring this breathtaking city, roam through its idyllic streets and admire its magnificent architecture. You can easily fill your day and evening trying out Bordeaux's many lovely cafes, top quality restaurants and quirky and unique bars.
