## **Location & Local Information**

If you don't mind travelling out a bit further, the pleasantly named Turtle Cove Marina is a great place to charter a boat, fish and enjoy water sports and tends to draw aficionados of boating and sailing.

The island of Providenciales offers so much more too. For instance, you might want to take in the lagoon permeated with islands and mangroves that is Chalk Sound National Park. The best way to explore this enchanting area is by kayak or paddleboard, which can both be rented.

If you're new to snorkelling or diving, Coral Gardens and



Smith's Reef both offer plenty of opportunities to explore the world beneath the water.

Conch is a local delicacy used in many meals on the island. A visit to Conch Farm will allow you to learn more about the conch and how they became so integral to the cuisine.

If you're in season, you can enjoy whale watching from January to April as the whales begin their migration. You might also want to take in the history and culture of the island with a visit to Cockburn Town on Grand Turk – a great opportunity to learn about the indigenous Lucayan people.

- If visiting during the peak season, make sure you make advance reservations for areas of interest to avoid disappointment.
