You're based in the very centre of Courchivel, a true skiers paradise. This is an ideal location, rendering you in close proximity to everything you could need in this most dazzling part of the world. The diverse terrain ensures that skiers can enjoy a range of versatile slopes, from those that border on the gentle to those ideally suited to those with more devil-may-care temperaments.

Connected to several major airports, you can easily arrive from Lyon, Geneva, Chambery or Grenoble within three hours, and from the airport, there is a vast array of transport options available to you, including a private taxi, rental service and shuttle service.

The Alps are, of course, a truly beguiling wonder; the woods are enchanting, and the small villages beam with life and tradition.
