
Heading downstairs reveals a spacious open-plan kitchen and dining room, skilfully designed with half the space dedicated to each function. Large, glazed doors connect the room to converted vaults, allowing ample daylight to illuminate this basement area. The kitchen boasts a contemporary utilitarian design, complete with a range of modern appliances, including a tall Smeg fridge, induction hob, electric cooker, and family-sized dishwasher.

A rustic wooden farmhouse table defines the dining area, providing seating for eight on upholstered chairs, while period-style crystal and brass wall sconces add an elegant touch for a delightful dinner party. The converted vaults cleverly house a cosy study and a large utility room.

On the first floor awaits the spectacular master bedroom, painted in a calming blue hue, with white plantation shutters and a decorative period fireplace. The king-size bed adorned with premium quality Egyptian cotton bedding ensures a restful night's sleep. Across the landing is the family bathroom, beautifully themed in blue and white, offering a separate glassencased shower and a full-length bath, ideal for relaxation.

The second floor accommodates another king-size bedroom, featuring calming neutrals and rooftop views across Lansdown Road and beyond. Across the landing, a third bedroom with a double bed provides views of Christ Church at the back of the building, and there's an additional toilet and washbasin for added convenience.
