The ground floor has an open-plan living space with floor-to-ceiling windows that frame captivating vistas of the deep blue sea stretching towards Patara Beach. The seating area has a comfy L-shaped sofa, a handy coffee table, authentic Turkish rugs, and a flat-screen smart television for your entertainment. A four-seat dining set provides a setting for shared meals. The modern kitchenette is fully equipped with all the latest appliances you will need to cater for your holidays.

The first of the two bedrooms can be found on this floor with a comfortable double bed and useful bedside tables. The beautifully-appointed shared bathroom has a glass-fronted walk-in shower, hand basin, bidet, and WC. Take the stairs to the mezzanine level, where you will find a bedroom snuggled under the eaves with a double bed.

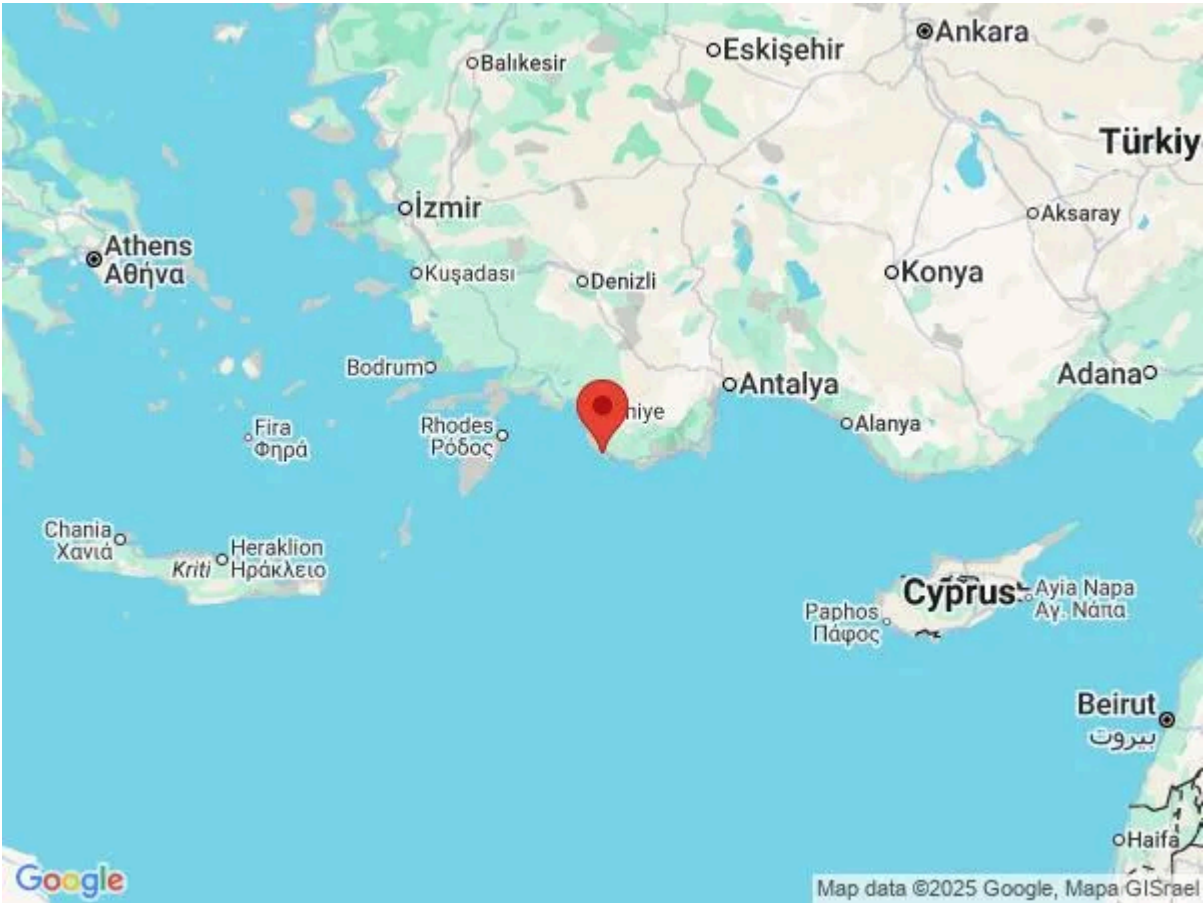
Villa Karanfil is around a scenic one hundred and ten-kilometre drive from Dalaman International Airport. The village of Gelemis has shops and minimarts to cater for your holiday needs, as well as lots of local cafes, authentic tavernas, and a quaint Post Office come art gallery. The incredible Patara Beach, a twenty-kilometre pristine stretch of coastline, is a two-kilometre walk from the villa and, in season, has the nesting Caretta Caretta turtles. Don't miss the fantastic sunsets, best viewed from the top of the sand dunes, cocktail in hand. After which, enjoy the nightlife in one of the live music bars.

In the village of Gelemis, there is a riding stable for horseback rides across the dunes and canoes to hire to surf the waves. History buffs can explore the awe-inspiring ruins of ancient Patara, with its well-preserved amphitheatre and Lycian tombs.

Kalkan's vibrant hot spot holiday resort is a fifteen-kilometre drive from Villa Karanfil, offering an array of shops, restaurants, banks, a Thursday market, and a charming harbour. Take the opportunity to spend the day at a beach club or all aboard for a boat trip, as the sun sets, enjoy a sundowner at a harbour sidebar before dining at one of the famous rooftop restaurants.

- Both bedrooms have double beds, perfect for a couple or couples sharing.
- The bedrooms are under the eaves, the ground floor bedroom at the back of the house, and the one on the mezzanine floor have sloping ceilings.
- Patara Beach has lovely shallow entry waters, but don't venture out too far, as it can be known to have rip tides.

- **Security deposit:** £100 paid in cash to the owner upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 14:00 - 00:00
- **Departure time:** 11:00
- **Energy costs included?:** Yes, included in the rental price.
- **Linen & towels included?:** Yes, included in the rental price.
- **Pets welcome?:** On request only and with prior agreement with the owner.
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Changeover day:** Flexible.
- **End of stay cleaning available?:** Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?:** Smoking & Vaping are not permitted.
- **Other 2:** In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases a bathroom bin is provided.
- **Minimum stay:** 4 nights during August and September.
 3 nights all other dates.
- **Heating costs included?:** Yes, included in the rental price.
- **Tax:** Included in the rental price.
- **Internet access?:** Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access is included in rental price. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on the local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.
- **Pool towels included?:** Yes, included in the rental price.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10 year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
