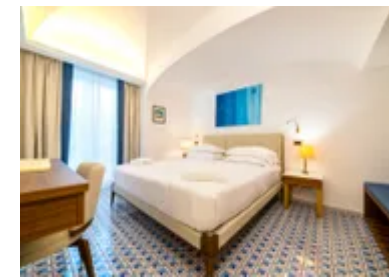

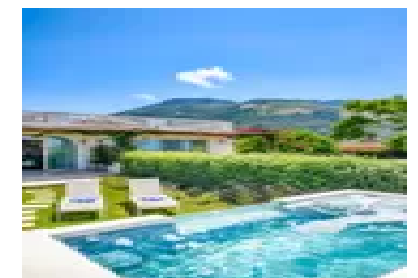
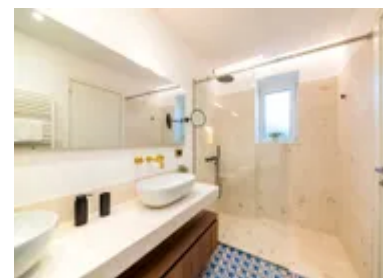
A bit further away, Forio is another picturesque village with an abundance of trattorias and pizza restaurants, as well as a museum, port and plenty of pretty winding streets.

- Whilst this property can comfortably sleep up to 4 guests, please note that 2 guests will be accommodated on the sofa bed in the living room.
- Situated in a private resort with similar neighbouring villas.
- Due to being located on the island of Ischia, a ferry is required to reach this property. Ferries run from Naples to Ischia all year round, although they are much more frequent from April to October than November to March.
