

Chateau Belle Rive

Region: Aquitaine **Sleeps:** 18

Overview

This beautiful French château sits by the riverside in the Lot-et-Garonne region of south-western France, within a short stroll of a pretty village. Embrace the romanticism of its interiors before swimming in its heated swimming pool, then relax by the river's edge with a glass of local wine.

Dating back to the mid-19th century, Château Belle Rive makes a fine holiday home or an elegant venue for a French wedding across its six acres of grounds. The reception rooms are so inviting with a characterful lounge and cosy snug alongside the dining hall and superbly equipped kitchen featuring an impressive Lacanche range. Original features can be found throughout from stone floors and wood beamed ceilings to exposed brickwork and gorgeous fireplaces, as well as modern touches and stylish décor.

The perfect blend of old and new can be found across the seven bedrooms which sleep up to 18 guests, each room with its own personality and character. French beds and antique furnishings add an immense amount of charm, as do the rolltop baths which stand proudly in many of the bedrooms. For additional guests, a 2-bedroom cottage can be added to your booking on request, subject to a supplement.

Swim in the heated swimming pool and enjoy long lunches prepared in the fantastic poolside kitchen beneath the trailing vines. Take a stroll through the château's vast gardens, stop off in the chai for a game of pool and drink by the bar, or simply find a picturesque spot on a south-facing terrace overlooking the River Lot. A small jetty allows you to canoe or fish (with a licence) along the river in this truly idyllic setting.

Pick up locally grown fruit and vegetables from the



neighbouring farm shop or stroll down to the local village with its épicerie selling fresh croissants and bread each morning. A traditional restaurant-bar is attached to the village shop for lunches or evening meals out whilst there are many further places to eat in riverside villages and towns such as Castelmoron-sur-Lot and Villeneuve-sur-Lot.

In a region famed for its orchards and fertile farmland, enjoy the wonderful markets of nearby villages and towns (including a summer's Farmer's market on a Thursday evening in the local village). Try the tomatoes from Marmande, prunes from Agen, wine from Duras as well as strawberries, nuts, courgettes, melons and of course *foie gras*, *magret* and delicious cheeses.

Hire seasonal pedalos, canoes and kayaks in Castelmoron-sur-Lot, discover riverside beaches for summer swimming and visit picture-perfect villages such as Pujols, Penne-d'Agenais and Monflanquin.

You could even venture north to the Dordogne with Monpazier, Issigeac and Bergerac all around an hour away, whilst other days out include the undulating landscapes of the Gers, the Malbec producing vineyards of Cahors and even the world-famous wineries of Bordeaux, amongst many more highlights of south-western France.

Location & Local Information


An idyllic setting by the banks of the Lot River with 200m of river frontage (including a small jetty, rowing boat and canoe), Château Belle Rive is in the Lot-et-Garonne department of south-western France, within walking distance to a pretty village and only 4km from Castelmoron-sur-Lot.

Wander down to the local village for your morning croissants and bread from the village épicerie and find a traditional bar-restaurant next door, both around 900m away. There is also a farm shop just down the lane from the château selling seasonal fruit and vegetables whilst the village hosts a Thursday evening Farmer's market in the height of the summer.

Soak up the ambience of further delightful markets in Castelmoron-sur-Lot (4km) on a Wednesday morning and Villeneuve-sur-Lot (16km) on a Tuesday and Saturday morning as well as others in places such as Marmande, Nérac, Agen, Cancon, Duras and plenty more villages and towns. Indeed, the Lot-et-Garonne is known for its fertile farmland and countryside - look out for tomatoes from Marmande and Agen prunes as well as locally grown strawberries, melons, nuts, asparagus, courgettes, good regional wines and a wealth of poultry, *foie gras*, *magret* and cheeses.

There are many activities across this part of south-western France from summer canoeing and kayaking along the Lot River to wonderful walks, cycle rides, tennis, golf and so much more. Discover other water based activities in July and August across *base de loisirs* dotted across the Lot-et-Garonne such as Lac de Lougratte (27km), Casteljaloux (50km) and by the river near Marmande (37km). There is also supervised summer swimming in the Lot River in Castelmoron-sur-Lot (4km) and Clairac (15km).

In terms of pretty villages, Pujols (15km) is classified as one of France's '*Plus Beaux Villages*' and hikers will appreciate the walk up to the village from Villeneuve-sur-



Lot. Penne-d'Agenais (27km) is an idyllic spot perched above the river whilst further north you will find the French bastide town of Monflanquin, another beautiful spot. Crossing over to the Dordogne department, visit Monpazier and Issigeac, both within an hour, or appreciate the beauty and history of Bergerac (61km) and take a river cruise along the Dordogne River.

Even more amazing days out include the idyllic villages and landscapes of the Gers (Larressingle, Montréal and Fourcès are just over an hour away), handsome Cahors (85km) with its Malbec producing vineyards, the UNESCO World Heritage vineyards of Saint-Émilion (93km) and even the grand city of Bordeaux (124km) with its world-famous wineries.
