This newly constructed, three-storey, detached retreat offers a serene escape. With four spacious double bedrooms, it can comfortably accommodate up to eight guests, perfect for large family gatherings or get-togethers with friends. This impressive villa comes complete with all the mod cons, including complimentary air conditioning and Wi-Fi throughout, secure parking, and old-fashioned mosquito nets.

The heart of Villa Dalaria is its spacious living room, an open-plan oasis of comfort and style that gives access to the pool terrace and gardens. The seating area has a two and three-seater comfy sofa, matching armchairs, a coffee table, a nest of side tables, a sideboard, and a large flat-screen television for your entertainment. A six-person dining table adds versatility for elegant indoor gatherings. The fully equipped white kitchen caters to culinary needs with all the latest built-in appliances, including a dishwasher, washing machine, fridge/freezer, microwave, oven and hob, and dinnerware for 12 people. A guest cloakroom completes the ground floor.

Take the central staircase to the upper floors, where you will see an atrium with a stunning chandelier. The villa is home to four well-appointed bedrooms, each featuring a double bed, bedside cabinets, fitted wardrobes, a vanity table, and an ensuite bathroom with walk-in showers, hand basins, and WCs. Every bedroom has a private balcony with views of the villa's pool and well-tended garden, inviting you to relax in the peaceful surroundings.

Outside, Villa Dalaria's well-manicured garden offers a leisurely escape. The private, step-entry swimming pool is surrounded by comfortable sun loungers and shaded



parasols, perfect for a day of relaxation. Al-fresco dining is a breeze at the six-person table, complemented by a cosy seating area for coffee and cocktails and a barbecue for grilling.

Location & Local Information


Villa Dalaria is nestled in the hills of the holiday hot spot of Hisaronu, a sixty-kilometre drive from Dalaman International Airport. It is perfectly situated betwixt and between the bustling town of Fethiye and the desirable resort destination of Oludeniz, both just fifteen minutes away. For holiday provisions, local shops and restaurants are just a four hundred metre walk away. Hisaronu is home to a host of supermarkets, cafes, bars, and restaurants, a busy nightlife, and some super souvenir shops too.

Take a short drive down to Oludeniz, where you will find one of the world's best blue flag, golden sandy beaches, the iconic and much-photographed blue lagoon, and spit, with a selection of adrenalin-inducing water sports. In the evening, the town comes alive with buzzing seashore restaurants and bars and a chance to indulge in some exclusive shopping. From Oludeniz, you can hop aboard a water taxi to Butterfly Valley or cross the sea to Gemile Island. For the thrill seekers, head up the hill and take the cable car to the top of Mount Babadag, and paraglide back down to Oludeniz beach.

For shopping and the city, Fethiye is your go-to destination, a harbour town with yachts moored the length of the coastline, home to an ancient amphitheatre, a historical museum and rock tombs, and an embarkation point for the obligatory Twelve Island boat trip. There is a foodie-heaven fish market, souvenir shops selling your favourite designer brands, and a local Tuesday market.

What we love

What you should know...

- All four bedrooms in Villa Dalaria have double beds, perfect for a group of friends' sharing, or a family holiday, with a room for each member.
- The village of Hisaronu is within walking distance, but the beaches of Oludeniz are a long walk down a very steep hill, there is lots of public transport to take you there and back, and taxis are relatively inexpensive.
- Villa Dalaria is one of four identical villas, great if there's a large group or family celebration travelling together, however please note that as the pictures are the same, views and furnishings may differ slightly.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** £200 paid to the property manager upon arrival and refunded upon departure, subject to full inspection.
- **Arrival time:** 4pm
- **Departure time:** 10am
- **Energy costs included?**: Yes, included in the rental price
- **Linen & towels included?**: Yes, included in the rental price
- **Pets welcome?**: No pets
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Turkey, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Changeover day:** Flexible
- **End of stay cleaning available?**: Yes. An extra cleaning fee of £70 - £100 is required for stays under 7 nights. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival. Any extra cleaning, laundry, maintenance and/or rubbish disposal required will be charged against the security deposit.
- **Smoking Allowed?**: No smoking
- **Other 2:** In Turkey the plumbing system is not designed to have paper and sanitary items flushed down the lavatory. In these cases, a bathroom bin is provided.
- **Minimum stay:** Please note that there is a minimum stay of 5-nights, this may be increased across peak dates
- **Internet access?**: Complimentary Wi-Fi internet access is included in rental price. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on the local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

Travelling to Turkey

All British (and most other nationalities) citizens require a full 10-year passport with at least 6 months validity to enter Turkey. UK passport holders are exempt from visa for tourist visits of up to 90 days within 180 days starting from the first entry date. For all other passports please visit the Turkish Government Website (<https://www.evisa.gov.tr/en/>) or the Turkish Consulate for details of whether you require a visa or not.

Whilst in Turkey local regulations require you keep your passport and a printed copy of your e-visa with you at all times.
