Location & Local Information


Fiskardo, on the northern tip of Kefalonia, is a beautifully preserved village with a distinctive charm. As the only settlement to survive the 1953 earthquake, it retains its original Venetian architecture, where pastel-hued façades line cobbled lanes dotted with boutique shops, galleries and artisan studios. Its lively harbour, framed by fishing boats and sleek yachts, is home to a selection of excellent restaurants, bars and cafés offering fresh seafood, traditional Greek fare and international cuisine.

The waterfront promenade is perfect for a sunset stroll, while the surrounding coastline is a haven for sailing, with easy access to yacht charters and hidden coves. Just a short drive away, Emblisi Beach's turquoise waters and limestone cliffs provide ideal conditions for swimming and snorkelling. Nearby, Dafnoudi Beach is reached via a scenic forest trail and offers a serene escape with natural caves and crystal-clear shallows. Foki Beach, shaded by olive trees, is especially suited to families with its calm, shallow waters.

Beyond the beaches, a walk to Fiskardo's lighthouse rewards visitors with sweeping coastal views, while the nearby village of Assos offers a peaceful bay and historic Venetian fortress. Further south, the spectacular Melissani Lake, set within an underground cave, can be explored by boat, its iridescent waters offering a truly memorable experience. This unspoilt corner of Kefalonia promises relaxation, discovery and a taste of authentic island life.
