Region: Italian Lakes **Sleeps:** 13

Overview

Based near Italy's largest lake, known for its crystal-clear water, Alborella is a testament to Italian elegance, blending historical charm with contemporary comforts.

The villa comfortably accommodates up to 13 guests across six bedrooms. The second floor houses three double bedrooms and a bedroom with a queen bed, two of which share a terrace with stunning lake vistas. The attic floor reveals a double bedroom with lake views and a bedroom with two single beds. The attic's large bathroom, complete with a double sink and hydromassage tub, adds a touch of indulgence to the entire space. Culinary experiences are elevated in the two kitchens – the central kitchen on the first floor is a chef's dream, equipped with high-end appliances and a dining table for 12 guests, while the ground-floor kitchen serves the outdoor area, perfect for al-fresco dining under the stars.

Outside, the villa's charm is undeniable. The private swimming pool, with convenient staircase access, is surrounded by comfortable sunbeds and umbrellas. Step outside into the garden to unveil a lush oasis of olive trees and centuries-old plants where you can relax uninterrupted.

Alborella's location is excellent for exploring Lake Garda's enchanting surroundings. Only a stone's throw away from Salò's centre, guests can enjoy romantic restaurants, chic shops, and a picturesque lakeside promenade. The villa is also a starting point for delightful walks, cycling, and trekking paths, with the lake's beaches and ferry connections to other atmospheric cities nearby.

Brescia, a former monastery with a grand basilica, cloisters and the Santa Giulia Museum, with items including Roman bronzes and medieval frescoes, is also a short drive away. You can explore the stunning Brescia Castle on Cidneo Hill or the Luigi Marzoli Arms Museum, which exhibits ancient weapons and armour.

A bit further away in Bergamo, walk around the cobblestone streets encircled by Venetian walls and accessible by funicular. The city is also home to the city cathedral, Duomo di Bergamo.

Location & Local Information

A cluster of typical Italian villages and rich countryside right next to northern Italy's Lake Garda make up the backdrop of Alborella's location, inviting you to immerse yourself in the local culture.

The villa is nestled in the outskirts of Salò, and offers more than just a great stay; it's a gateway to the diverse and captivating region of northern Italy. This splendid location, a stone's throw from the shimmering Lago di Garda, is an excellent base for exploring the rich tapestry of landscapes, history, and culture this area boasts. A short distance away are local amenities, such as a restaurant. If you need to stop for essentials, then the supermarket can be reached in 5 minutes by car.

A short drive away from the villa, Lago di Garda, Italy's largest lake, awaits with its azure waters and picturesque towns. The lake is a hub for various water sports, from sailing to windsurfing, and its shores are dotted with charming cafés and restaurants. The promenade in Salò is perfect for leisurely strolls, offering stunning views and a taste of local life.

In just 30 minutes by car, you can reach the city of Brescia. With its Roman ruins and Renaissance squares, is a treasure trove for history enthusiasts. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2011, the site is a delight for every architecture lover and features the monumental complex of San Salvatore – Santa Giulia. After exploring, refuel with coffee and sweet delights in one of the local bistros and cafés.

Bergamo, only 1 hour by car is renowned for its picturesque Città Alta (Upper City), encircled by Venetian walls. This historic area, accessible by a funicular, boasts cobblestone streets, medieval architecture, and the stunning Piazza Vecchia, making it a fantastic destination for a day trip.

Nature lovers will be drawn to the Parco dell'Alto Garda Bresciano and Parco delle Orobie Bergamasche. These parks offer many hiking and biking trails, showcasing the region's natural beauty, from lush valleys to rugged mountain peaks.

For those craving urban excitement, Milan, Italy's fashion and cultural capital, is within a 2-hour drive away. Famous for its high-end shopping, stunning Gothic cathedral, and vibrant art scene, Milan provides an option for a day trip for those looking to immerse themselves in Italian sophistication and style. Football enthusiasts can tour the famous San Siro Stadium, while others might stroll in the city's green park, Parco Sempione.
