Overview

Burrowed in the picturesque landscapes of Tuscany, this traditional stone home offers an authentic and charming retreat overlooking wooded hills and verdant valleys. Enjoying a rural location, yet only 3km from the nearest town, Villa Camucia offers guests the best of both worlds.

The main villa is a two-storey masterpiece which exudes timeless appeal with original features like shuttered windows, terracotta floor tiles, and wooden ceiling beams. Recent, tasteful renovations mean the interiors combine antique charm with modern comfort, as the home boasts plush furnishings, soft lighting, Wi-Fi, and air conditioning.

This villa comprises two buildings: the main villa, a stunning three-bedroom stone home, and the annexe, a quaint cottage on the grounds. The ground floor of the main house unveils a beautiful living room where sofas and armchairs gather around a crackling fireplace, complemented by a TV and a much-appreciated wine cellar. A small dining space within this room adds to the cosy atmosphere, while a larger dining room nearby offers a backdrop for delicious evening meals. The country-style kitchen is fully equipped for culinary endeavours; you will find all the crockery and gadgets in the cupboards.

Ascending the original staircase, three bedrooms on the upper floor provide serene havens for restorative sleep. Two double rooms showcase honey-hued walls and subtle lavender tones in soft furnishings, capturing the essence of the local landscape. The third bedroom offers flexibility, accommodating either a double or twin beds. Two contemporary shower rooms serve these bedrooms, combining functionality with tasteful design.

A stroll through the manicured 3000m2 garden reveals the cosy annexe, a comfortable garden cottage accommodating two additional guests. The main room features a delightful sofa transforming into a double bed, accompanied by a dining table, a wood burner, and a well-equipped kitchen. A convenient shower room completes this cosy retreat.

Outdoors, the home's allure extends to multiple dining areas bathed in sunlight or shaded by surrounding greenery. Sun loungers beckon relaxation by the large private swimming pool, offering breathtaking views of the Tuscan landscape. The fragrant lavender, manicured lawns, and thoughtfully landscaped gardens enhance the ambience.

You must travel far from the villa to uncover ancient pilgrim trails, forested hiking routes and the charming town of Cortona. Just 3km away, the town offers plenty of eateries, plus lots to see and do.

Further afield, you can visit the beautiful Lake Trasimeno and spend your days shopping and soaking in some culture in cities such as Arezzo and Perugia.
